#### **HWDSB school board discussion**

**Rousseau funding for re-build** the board will be applying again when funding opens up for new school builds. Expecting that will be before the end of the school year. It is still a board priority to get the funding for Rousseau to be re-built.

**School budget cuts** secondary to Provincial budget announcement. Less impact expected at elementary school level - classroom teacher staffing will depend on enrollment - however EPO funding was decreased and other supplementary resources expected to be pulled back.

**EQAO** - an imperfect tool used for detailed analysis of gaps and strengths among students in specific schools and identifying opportunities for improvement of instruction and distribution of resources. A presentation about EQAO will be shared with the school council and a Q&A session organized.

A discussion took place around program planning and distribution of supportive resources across board schools, including how needs assessment and program evaluation took place.

Some questions about parameters for assessment of the full day kindergarten program were brought up.
