PLEASE NOTE:

- To be eligible for a credit, students will be required to complete course material and write the final exam as scheduled – Full Credit exams will be written July 26, 2018. There will be no exceptions. Please plan accordingly.
- Half credit courses like Civics and Careers will have final evaluations scheduled at the midway point of the course. Students must be in attendance for all course evaluations to be eligible for the credit to be granted. Expect exams for these courses on July 13 (with courses ending on July 16, 2018). There will be no exceptions. Please plan accordingly.
- More than 3 absences for Full Credit courses (more than one absence for Civics, Careers, Math Transfer course) or unacceptable behaviour will result in the student being withdrawn from the course.
- Classes can be cancelled, combined or relocated due to insufficient enrolment. If your class is cancelled you will be contacted by CCE staff to discuss other options.
