- You must have earned a minimum of 26 credits by end of semester 1.
- You must be scheduled to take the remaining courses needed to complete the 18 compulsory credits and the 12 optional credits for a total of 30 credits by mid-term semester 2.
- You must have submitted documentation of 40 hours of community volunteer activities by March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- You must have successfully completed the Provincial Secondary School Literacy Requirement **or** be scheduled to take the literacy test or the literacy course.
