Overview of the Accommodation Review Process





The Accommodation Review Process:

- The process follows Ministry of Education guidelines, Board Policy and the Terms of Reference
- There are committee working meetings and public meetings.
 - All meetings are open to the public
- The Accommodation Review Committee (ARC) is tasked with developing an accommodation solution that will address the long-term requirements of the community





ARC Recommendations:

- The ARC will prepare a report that will be presented to the Board of Trustees
 - This report will include the ARC's recommendations
- The Trustees will also receive a report from Senior Administration with their recommendations to the Board of Trustees
- The Board of Trustees will make the final decisions






ARC Timelines:

- 13 Working Group Meetings
- 4 Public Meetings
- ARC work scheduled to conclude in February 2012
- After receipt of final report,
 Trustees have to wait a minimum of 60 days prior to voting on a final decision
- Final report due to the Director of Education by February 3, 2012

 - Closing only Highland/Parkside and constructing a new facility
 - Construction of the new facility on the Parkside site
 - Closing all three schools and building one new facility
 - Collaboration with the South ARC
 - Alternate site locations in Dundas and Ancaster
- What we would like to see in the absence of funding from the Ministry of Education
- Recommended programs and proposed locations
- Additional considerations such as the construction of new theatres and the implementation timelines

West ARC Recommended Option






The mandate of this committee, acting in accordance with the Board's Pupil Accommodation Review Policy, is to produce a report to the Board that encompasses the following:

- a) Accommodation: Develop recommendations to maximize the utilization of Board facilities in the review area with a target of 100% utilization for a future ten-year period
- **b) Facility Condition:** Develop recommendations for capital improvements (i.e. repairs, renovations or major capital projects such as new construction) into existing facilities and sites along with a funding strategy to pay for those improvements.
- c) Program: Develop recommendations around the strategic locations of Secondary School programs.
- **d) Transportation:** Develop recommendations that address the implications of other recommendations on pupil transportation.
- **e) Funding:** Develop a funding strategy to address any capital works that are contemplated in the recommendations above.
- f) Implementation: Timelines for school closures
- **g) Scope:** Ancaster High Highland Parkside Westdale
- h) Timeline: Final ARC Report Due on February 3, 2012












West ARC Accommodation Recommendations:

- The closure of Highland and Parkside and the construction of a new school on the Highland site (~1,000 pupil places)
- The closure of Ancaster and the construction of a replacement school on the existing site (~1,000 pupil places)
- The existing schools that have been identified for closure will remain open until new schools have been built

Legacy Cost of the West ARC Recommendation:

- With the closure of Ancaster, Highland and Parkside the West ARC recommendation would eliminate approximately \$32 million in deferred capital maintenance (i.e., replacement of windows, boilers, roofs, etc.)
- From approximately \$54 million under the current situation to \$22 million for the ARC recommendation





Parkside Secondary School

- Closure of facility in June 2015
- The entire existing catchment area will become part of the new school to be constructed on the Highland site





Highland Secondary School

- Closure of facility in June 2015
- Proposed construction of a new ~1,000 pupil place secondary school on the Highland site
- Boundary to include all of the existing Highland and Parkside catchment areas
- Target Opening Date: September 2015

- Boundary to include all of the existing Ancaster catchment area
- Target Opening Date: September 2015

Additional Recommendations:

- That the new schools will have no less than 1,000 pupil places
- That the existing programs and the appropriate space in the current schools be retained if moved to any new or modified school subject to consultation with the community and schools
- That any new school will include space for community partnerships where interest and support is evident

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Additional Recommendations (con't):

- To include a theatre style auditorium on each school site and if necessary shared spaces with a music and or theatre focus
- That the Facilities Management Department will consult with the principals and specialists to ensure that the remaining facilities are upgraded to meet the program strategy and address the renewal needs as outlined by the West ARC
