SPECIALIZED AND PERSONALIZED LEARNING

The HWDSB Tennis Academy - In partnership with the Rosedale Tennis Club, students at all skill levels have the opportunity to develop fundamental tennis skills as taught by our on-staff Ontario Certified Association certified instructor. Off court development includes enhanced leadership and healthy lifestyle choices.

Outbound - Outbound is a 4 credit integrated program offered to all students in the HWDSB. Outbound integrates grade 12 courses in Science, Geography, English, and Physical and Health Education in a program which develops practical skills related to communication, leadership, outdoor education, and environmental awareness.

SPECIALIST HIGH SKILLS MAJOR (SHSM)

Health and Wellness - This multiple credit package offered in Grade 11 and 12, combines Health and Wellness with Child and Family Services. Over a 2 year, four semester period, students will receive First Aid, CPR, and WHMIS training, experiential/co-operative opportunities at either the apprenticeship, college, university, or workplace level, and a specialized seal on their diploma upon successful completion of the program of study.

PATHWAY PROGRAMS

Living and Working with Children - Focusing on children from birth to 6 years of age, this program offers students interested in a career in working with children the opportunity to receive both in-class theoretical training, and an opportunity to leave the classroom behind to gain valuable workplace training in the form of a co-op placement.

Hairstyling Apprenticeship Program - This two credit package in Grade 11 and 12 allows students to learn fundamental skills related to hair, skin, and nail care. In addition, students can combine these Delta courses with the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) as part of a workplace training component through a co-op placement. Successful students will receive Level 1 Apprenticeship Certification.
