Orchard Park offers a wide range of academic programs to meet the needs of all our students. Our school has a diverse and multicultural population and the staff and students work together to promote a safe, respectful and nurturing environment.

### PROGRAMS OF CHOICE

**Robotics** - The Robotics program at Orchard Park builds self-confidence, knowledge and life skills while motivating young people to pursue opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Students have the opportunity to participate in a number of robotics competitions in a way that combines the excitement of sport with science and technology. This program helps high school students discover the rewarding and engaging process of innovation and engineering.

**Basketball Academy** - The Basketball Academy at Orchard Park emphasizes basketball fundamentals, individual skill development goal setting, rules, team concepts, fitness and healthy living and a mentoring/coaching component.

**Football Academy** - The Orchard Park Football Academy will emphasize football fundamentals, individual skill development, goal setting, rules, team building, weight training/fitness, and a mentoring/coaching component. This program is partnered with Football Canada and the Ontario Football Alliance to develop Long Term Athlete Development based Grade 9 to Grade 12 curriculum. Students will also receive coaching (Level 1) and referee certifications as they progress through the program.

**Fashion and Aesthetics** - This program is currently available for grade 9 to 11 students. The program focus is on the fashion industry in Canada. It is an interdisciplinary program drawing on the curriculums from Art, Business, Family Studies and Cosmetology. Students take courses that prepare them to work in a variety of careers in the fashion industry. Cooperative education, work experience and field trips are key components of this program. The program has two streams – fashion and cosmetology. Students may choose to complete courses in one or both streams.

### SPECIALIST HIGH SKILLS MAJOR (SHSM)

**Hospitality and Tourism** - Students will learn about food preparation, hospitality services and tourism. Through experiential learning, students will connect with hospitality employers, and explore post secondary career options in the industry. They will also participate in training and certification in customer service, safe food handling, Smart Serve, Standard First Aid and CPR. This program is open to students in all pathways.
