- Jane- Bake sale makes her nervous, We can't guarantee they are Nut Free, breaks board policy
- What else is happening in December for the kids?
  - Student Council will do all the 'fun days' like: PJ Day, Hat Dat, Crazy Hair day etc.
- This could be too big a task for this year, maybe another year?
