## Courses without descriptions in the Board Course Calendar

**AMR201 - Music Repertoire - Concert Band-** This is a full year course available to students who have <u>also</u> selected instrumental music (AMU). Participating students will be surveyed to determine if the course is held before school, during lunch periods or after school.

**AMV201 - VOCAL MUSIC** - An introduction to vocal production through technical, choral and solo work. Students will learn to appreciate the language of music as they develop and strengthen their singing voices.

AWS201 - DIGITAL MEDIA - This hands-on course introduces students to computer graphics. Students explore art related software programs such as Adobe Photoshop, InDesign, and animation software. Students combine fine art and computer skills while working with typefaces, design principles, graphic elements, digital images and freehand illustrations. Students create an array of designs and explore various technologies such as online platforms, digital cameras, 3D, scanners, and studio lighting. The study of current trends and developments in new media will support all studio projects.
