Graduation Ceremony

Time:	Graduating students: Arrive promptly at FirstOntario Concert Hall (formerly Hamilton Place)
	by 5:30 p.m. and enter the building through the " Studio " doors off of Summers Lane.
	Parents, family and guests: 5:30 p.m doors to the lobby area open
	6:00 p.m doors to seating area open
	6:30 p.m ceremony begins
Location:	FirstOntario Concert Hall – formerly Hamilton Place (1 Summers Lane, Hamilton, ON)

Eligibility

Participation in the graduation ceremony is contingent on students having met the requirements to earn either a high school diploma or certificate. Students must make every effort to meet requirements in the required timelines in order for the school to prepare for the program, ordering of gowns, seating etc.

Tickets

Please have your son/daughter indicate the number of tickets you require when they complete their grad survey. The grad survey can be found under the quick links on our school website. Seating for family and guests is general admission and on a first come, first serve basis once the doors are open (doors will be open 30 minutes prior to the ceremony start). Once you have gained admission to your section you are free to sit in any row but please move as far as possible to the middle of the row leaving no empty seats between you and others already seated. Students, who have paid their grad fee (\$75) and completed the grad survey by the Friday, May 24th deadline, will receive their tickets at the Grad Breakfast (Friday, May 31st). After these timelines, students can come to Student Services to complete these tasks.

Community Involvement Hours

The 40 hours of volunteer service must be completed and submitted prior to **June 1st**. Failure to meet this deadline may affect whether the student's name will appear in the graduation program if they are submitted after this date.

Graduation Gowns

Graduating students are to pick up their cap and gown in Student Services on **Tuesday**, **June 25th between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m**. Students are responsible for bringing their cap and gown to the graduation ceremony. There **will not** be any extra gowns available at the ceremony. Gowns must be returned promptly following the end of the ceremony.

Photos

It is advised that graduation photos with cap/gown are taken prior to the ceremony. Given the large size of the graduating class there is limited space for photographs and movement in the lobby at FirstOntario Concert Hall. There will be a professional photographer who will take a picture of each graduating student as they receive their diploma. The picture(s) will be given to students at the end of graduation when they return their gown.

Graduation Portfolios

A graduation portfolio will be available for pick up at WDHS from **July 8 through to July 19** between the hours of **8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.** The portfolio contains a class composite photograph (for those who opted for formal graduation pictures through Edge Imaging), a graduation diploma/certificate, any award certificates, the final report card and transcript.

Graduation Portrait Retakes

A \$75.00 grad fee will be charged to each student. This fee helps defray the following cost:
