Dear Parents and School Community:

The Westwood School Council had a very rewarding year. The school council held 5 meetings on September 30th, November 4th, January 13th, March 23rd, and May 18th and worked on various issues during the year including Math Night, fundraising, Multicultural Day, the School Transportation Plan, and a new Council Code of Ethics, By-laws and Constitution, just to name a few. These meetings were open to the public to encourage input from parents and other members of the school community. The purpose of the school council is to help improve student achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents. School councils are advisory organizations. A school council's primary means of achieving its purpose is by making recommendations to the principal of the school and the school board. Boards and principals are responsible for considering the recommendations made by each school council and for advising the council(s) of the actions taken in response to the recommendations. Accordingly, the advice that the school council provided to the principal and to the school board in 2015-2016, as well as the responses from the principal and school board on how this advice was taken into account in decision making can be found within the council meeting minutes which are publicly available on the <u>Westwood School web site</u> at

- Organized and facilitated the Coffee/Tea fundraiser to purchase outdoor play equipment and musical supplies for students
- Organized and facilitated a successful Math & Nutrition nights for families

• Organized and facilitated a successful Multicultural Day for students

• Advocated for a pathway between Westwood School and Westmount Recreation Center Fundraising activities were also conducted, and the proceeds were used to fund projects in accordance with school board policies.
