# The Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board in partnership with local Home Builders and Habitat For Humanity

The "Building Careers" Program is intended to provide career preparation for students with an interest in Residential Building Construction careers. Students will have the opportunity to work with a Construction Technology teacher and build a house.

Students will also complete Cooperative Education placements with building trades doing work at various building sites in the region. Placements could include electrical, plumbing, framing, bricklaying, general contracting and many more.

This program is available in both semesters, and requires students to commit for the entire day, all semester. Students have the opportunity to earn up to 6 credits in this program.

Building Careers program includes many of the components which would allow students to earn a **Specialist High Skills Major** designation on their Ontario Secondary School Diploma if student is currently enrolled in a Construction SHSM.

#### To be eligible for this unique program, students:

- must be 16 years of age or older;
- 2. **must** submit all required application information by the due date
- 3. **must** attend an orientation session
- 4. **must** have completed at least one Senior Construction Technology course

#### Please be advised of the following policies:

- 1. Students are not guaranteed acceptance to the program by submitting an application.
- 2. This an all-day program consisting of two (2) Construction Technology credits (TCJ4E2), and up to 4 credits through co-operative education.
- 3. Transportation to school, to the house-building site, and to placements is the responsibility of the student.
- 4. Students will be required to purchase suitable attire and tools for this program (work clothing, safety boots, etc).
- 5. In accordance with the Municipal Freedom of Information Act, 1989, students/parents will be asked to consent for Social Insurance information and images/photographs to be kept on file and used in future promotional/information materials and/or publications by the Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board.
