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Dear Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board Families,

Welcome back to the new school year! Thank you for joining us at HWDSB as we help all students achieve their full potential.

You may know that Ontario's school boards are implementing the Ministry of Education's revised Health and Physical Education (HPE) curriculum this year. The revised curriculum replaces the 1998 version.

The revised curriculum focuses on the foundations of living a healthy and active life. This includes teaching about human development and sexual health. We know that this can be a sensitive topic, and we know that some parents have concerns. We want to share how families can learn more and ask questions.

Teaching about Human Development and Sexual Health is not new in Ontario school boards. The revised HPE curriculum reflects the realities that today's students face regarding their health, safety and well-being. It contains new material related to important issues - healthy relationships, consent, mental health, online safety and the risks of sexting - and is more inclusive of Ontario's diverse population.

HWDSB is preparing its staff to deliver the revised curriculum, with the understanding that this can be a sensitive topic for some families. We want to ensure that our delivery of the revised curriculum will be done in a thoughtful way, with the understanding of our parent community.

We want parents to be well-informed about what their children will learn. For this reason, we are holding three Information Sessions on the revised Health and Physical Education curriculum. This is an opportunity for parents to ask questions, have their questions addressed and learn more about the curriculum.
