Re: East Hamilton & Lower Stoney Creek French Immersion Relocation Transition Plan

As you know, based on your feedback, Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) staff have investigated all possible options for the relocation of the French Immersion program from Glen Echo and Glen Brae.

HWDSB Trustees plan to make a final decision regarding the transition plan at a Board meeting that starts at 6 p.m. Monday, Feb. 26, 2018. Meetings are open to the public and live-streamed on the HWDSB website. In the days ahead, you will be able to find details about this meeting and motion going to Trustees at www.hwdsb.on.ca/about/trustees/meetings.

After the decision at this meeting, we will send affected communities a letter providing details and next steps. This decision and planning was based on the Dec. 18, 2017 Board motion from the East Hamilton and Lower Stoney Creek French Immersion Boundary Review for East Hamilton and Lower Stoney Creek.


We know that this process has been challenging as we strive to provide the best option for students. Thank you to the families who shared their thoughts to help guide planning.
