
West Hamilton City Pupil Accommodation Review Board Motion June 2017:

Guiding Principles

- Balanced and healthy enrolment in both FI and Regular Track programs
- Reduced reliance on portable classrooms
- Preferred K-8 model for elementary schools*
- Equity of access, opportunity and distribution of programs

*While having fewer and more effective transitions for students in elementary schools is our goal, HWDSB facilities restrict our ability to implement the preferred K-8 model in all schools.

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

- New French Immersion location at Bennetto (grades 1-8)
- Current FI grade ones & twos in new Bennetto FI boundary will attend Bennetto for FI grades 2 & 3 in September 2018
- New FI grade 1 entry are assigned to new FI boundaries each year, starting in 2018.
- Program will grow by a grade each subsequent year. Grade 8 projected by 2023.

- Students with older siblings in FI at Earl Kitchener or AM Cunningham living in new Bennetto FI boundary may stay until grade 5. After grade 5, they transition to Bennetto for grade 6 unless they have an older sibling in FI at Ryerson, Glen Brae (or eventually WH Ballard)
- Grade 1's entering FI may attend Earl Kitchener or AM Cunningham if they have an older sibling enrolled in FI at the school.

Transportation

- Eligible students in the new Bennetto FI boundary will receive transportation according to the Transportation Policy and Procedure.
- If families choose to keep younger students at Earl Kitchener, AM Cunningham, Ryerson or Glen Brae with the older sibling, no transportation will be provided for the younger sibling.
- Courtesy transportation may be available according to our Transportation Policy and Procedure.



Transition Activities

- Personalized communication with families
- Preparation for Bennetto staff to welcome a new program and create English/French environment.
- Activities for current students in grades one and two as they move to Bennetto
