Dear Families,

As you may know, Trustees at Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) today celebrated the announcement of the next milestone in the construction phase of the new 46,000 square foot elementary school in Greenville, Ontario.

Board Chair Todd White announced that HWDSB had received approvals from the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change with respect to the new sanitary and storm water systems.

In addition, Chair White announced that he expects to have site plan approvals from the City of Hamilton in the next four weeks. Building permits will follow shortly after this. HWDSB thanks city staff for their co-operation on this important step forward on the project.

Construction on the new school will begin shortly after the project is tendered. The tender phase is scheduled to begin in June. Shovels could be in the ground in July.

In June 2014, HWDSB Trustees approved the closure of Greenville and Spencer Valley and the construction of a new school on the Greenville school site. The new school will accommodate 381 students. It is a joint community project with the City of Hamilton, the Hamilton Public Library and the Ontario government.
