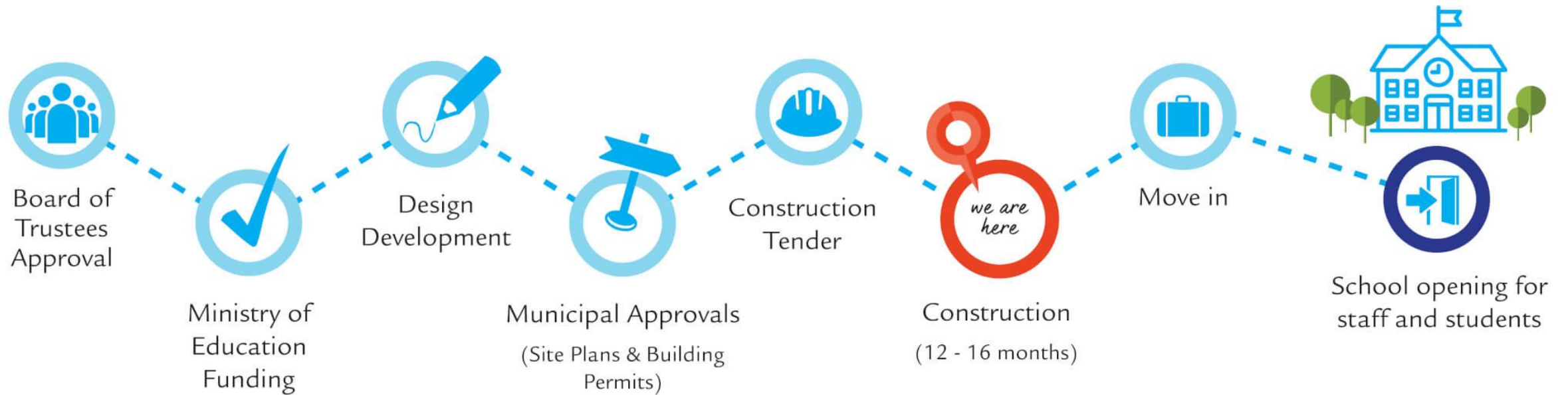

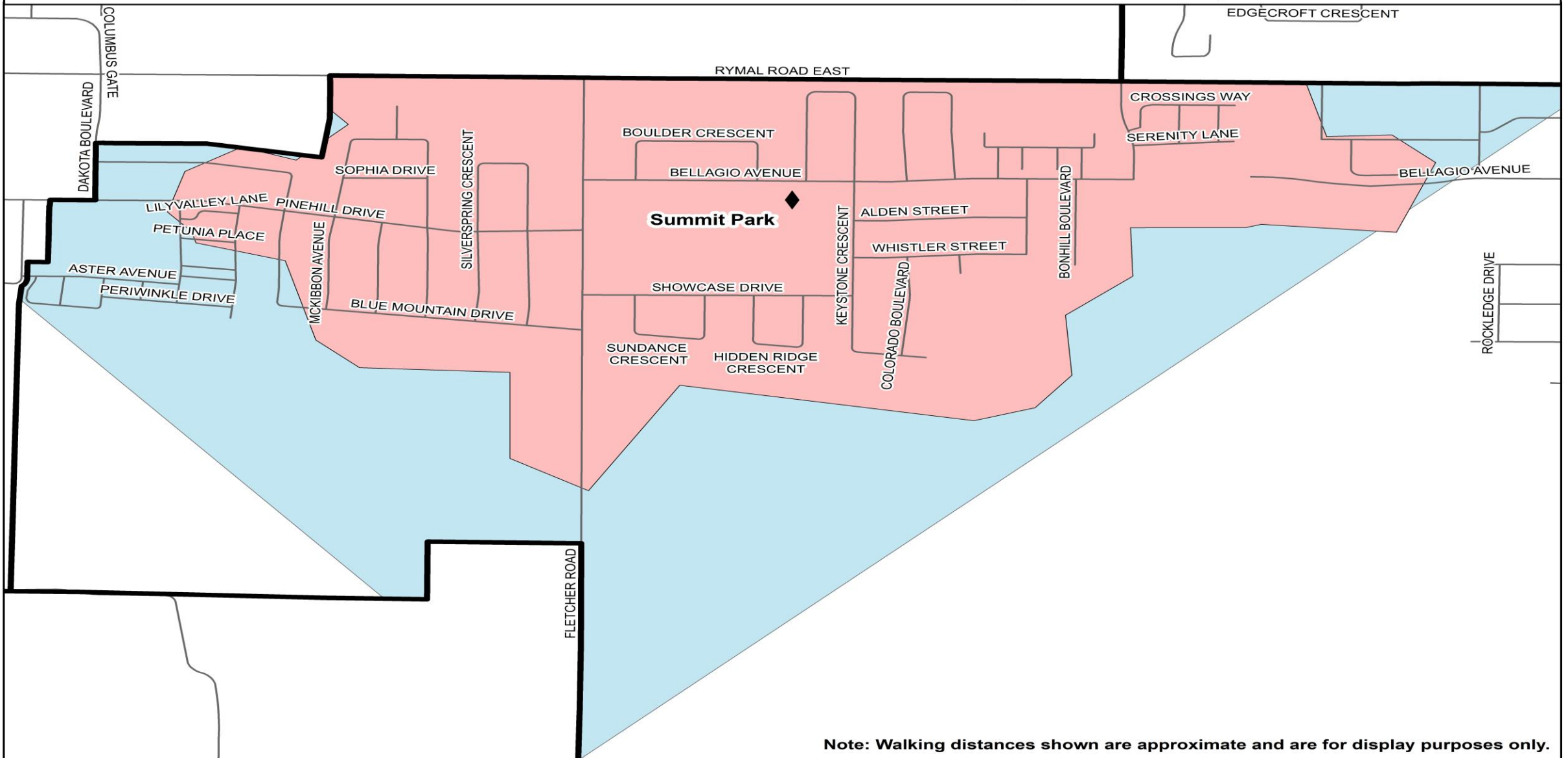

New Summit Park School - Walking Boundary



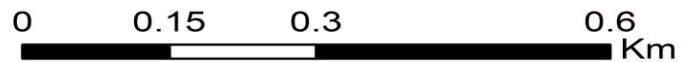
Note: Walking distances shown are approximate and are for display purposes only.
