Reporting to the Lead Supervisor of Electrical Services, the incumbent will perform inspection, maintenance, and repairs on the Board's electrical systems.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Perform a full range of functions such as installation, maintenance and repair of appropriate building services
- Maintain, adjust, repair or install all types of electrical equipment having complex interlocking or interrelated circuits, eg. generators, transformers, switch-boards, controllers, circuit breakers, motors, heating units, conduit systems or other transmission equipment, proven experience with frequency drives installations and troubleshooting
- Test continuity of circuits, diagnose problems and suggest corrective action
- Identify hazardous materials prior to commencement of work and be prepared to work within an asbestos and confined space environment
- Working at heights which may exceed 10 metres
- Assume responsibility for the work and equipment allocated
- Provide estimates for assigned Work Orders
- Responsible for the acquisition of supplies, inventory-related duties and the completion of required paperwork reports, time sheets and logs etc. connected specifically with work assigned (scheduled).
- Truck driving and delivery of product which may include trailer towing, material acquisition for delivery and/or set-up of equipment, and light truck vehicle cleaning and maintenance
- Other duties as assigned by Maintenance Supervisor Personnel
