Pupil Accommodation Review Directive -Section 4: The Final Staff Report

- Board staff will prepare a report (*Final Staff Report*) for the *Director of Education*, which will be presented to the Board of Trustees in public session at a regularly scheduled meeting or a special meeting as identified in Section 7.0 – Timelines.
- As per the *Pupil Accommodation Review Guideline,* the *Final Staff Report* "must include a Community Consultation section that contains feedback from the Advisory Committee and any public consultations as well as any relevant information obtained from municipalities and other community partners prior to and during the pupil accommodation review."

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



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Ancaster Initial Option

- CH Bray New construction 564 pupil place JK-8 school on CH Bray Site
- Ancaster Senior: Addition 465 pupil place school Eng/FI JK-8 school
- Rousseau: Addition 495 pupil place school Eng/FI JK-8 school
- Boundary review between Queen's Rangers and new school on Beverly Community Centre site
- Closure of Fessenden and Queen's Rangers.







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Work of the Advisory Committee


- Completed 6 working group meetings, 2 public meeting and a tour of a new HWDSB facility.
- Throughout the working group meetings, the advisory committee members expressed concerns, ideas and 3 options for Trustee consideration.
- The options and key feedback are summarized as follows...




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Advisory Committee Option #1

- Ancaster Senior: Addition 488 pupil place JK-8 Eng/FI school
- CH Bray: New Construction 495 pupil place JK-8 school on CH Bray Site
- Queen's Rangers: 176 pupil place JK-8 school. Repurpose two classrooms to create system wide Outdoor Education Program
- Rousseau: Addition 395 pupil place JK-8 Eng/FI school
- Closure of Fessenden.









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Advisory Committee Option #2

- Ancaster Senior/Fessenden Site: New construction or addition to Ancaster Senior facility – 518 pupil place JK-8 Eng/FI school
- Ancaster High Site: New construction 541 pupil place JK-8 school (Committee requests that Taylor Rd. is not used as access to new elementary School)
- Rousseau: New construction 423 pupil place JK-8 Eng/FI school
- Closure of CH Bray, Queen's Rangers and Fessenden.

Proposed boundary review after the accommodation review for Queen's Rangers and surrounding school communities









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Advisory Committee Option #3

- Ancaster High: Addition 200 pupil place wing on Ancaster High School for 7/8
- Ancaster Senior: Addition 550 pupil place JK-6 Eng and grade 1-8 FI school
- CH Bray: New Construction 328 pupil place JK-6 school
- Queen's Rangers: 153 pupil place JK-6 school Repurpose three classrooms to early years/childcare partnership
- Rousseau: School remains 291 pupil place JK-6 school
- Closure of Fessenden.









Key Feedback for Trustee Consideration


- Preserve Ancaster's Small and Intimate Community Schools

- Traffic and Student Safety




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Staff Recommendation

- CH Bray: New Construction 564 pupil place JK-8 school
- Rousseau: New Construction 495 pupil place Eng/FI JK-8 school
- Ancaster Senior: Addition 465 pupil place Eng/FI JK-8 school
- Boundary review between Queen's Rangers and surrounding communities, immediately following the PAR decision
- Closure of Fessenden and Queen's Rangers
- 3 business case submissions for a total of \$29.3 million.







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Staff Recommendation Rationale

- ✓ Improves learning environments
- ✓JK-8 schools
- ✓ Dual Track School (English/French)
 - ✓ Creates availability of FI in new location
- ✓ 2 of 3 facilities: 500 600 students per school



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Staff Recommendation Rationale

- ✓90% 110% Utilization
- ✓ Reduction of two facilities from inventory
- ✓ Removes portables/portapaks
- ✓ New buildings will improve accessibility and energy efficiency
- ✓ Reduction of \$17.9 million in renewal needs



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




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Initial Staff Recommendation

- Modify attendance boundaries for Bennetto, Cathy Wever, Dr. Davey, and Strathcona:
- Hess students to Bennetto (95%)
- Hess students to Strathcona (5%)
- For all boundary changes, see map
- Closure of Hess.





Work of the Advisory Committee


- The advisory committee worked diligently through working group meetings analyzing information, inquiring on education processes and funding, and exploring new accommodation ideas.
- In total, the committee sought analysis on eight new accommodation ideas. The committee sought public feedback on five of the ideas at Public Meeting #2.
- These ideas are captured in the Final Report and are summarized as follows...



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Work of the Advisory Committee - Ideas

- A. All schools remain open and no changes to school boundaries.
 - Bennetto introduces and FI 1-8 program.
 - FI boundary changes for Earl Kitchener and Ryerson.






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Work of the Advisory Committee - Ideas

- B. All schools remain open and there are proposed changes to school boundaries and programming.
 - Bennetto introduces and FI 1-8 program.
 - FI boundary changes for Earl Kitchener and Ryerson.






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Work of the Advisory Committee - Ideas

- C. Hess and Strathcona combine into a new 600 pupil place JK-8 school on a site to be determined and Bennetto introduces FI.
 - Suggested site to be SJAM
 - Bennetto introduces and FI 1-8 program.
 - FI boundary changes for Earl Kitchener and Ryerson.






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Work of the Advisory Committee - Ideas

- D. Hess and Strathcona combine into a new JK-5 school on a site to be determined and Bennetto introduces FI.
 - Suggested site to be SJAM
 - Grade 5 at new school move to Ryerson for grade 6
 - Bennetto introduces and FI 1-8 program.
 - FI boundary changes for Earl Kitchener and Ryerson.






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Work of the Advisory Committee - Ideas

- E. Hess and Strathcona combine into a new JK-8 school on a site to be determined (TBD). Central, EK, and Ryerson combine into 2 new JK-8 schools sites TBD. Bennetto introduces FI.
 - Hess/Strathcona suggested site to be SJAM
 - Central/EK/Ryerson sites to be determined
 - Bennetto introduces and FI 1-8 program
 - FI boundary changes for Earl Kitchener and Ryerson.



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Advisory Committee Consensus


- Three main points emerged from the consultation process that the committee wishes to express to trustees:
- 1. The desire is to keep all schools open
- 2. Should trustees decisions not represent retaining all current schools, the following ideas (listed previously) were most supported;
 - Idea B
 - Idea C
- 3. There is strong opposition to the Initial Staff Option. The committee also stated their confidence that the community voice expressed this as well.



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Final Staff Recommendation

- New Construction 600 pupil place JK-8 school on Hess site
- Bennetto: New 1-8 FI Program (starting with grades 1-3)
- Earl Kitchener/Ryerson: Revised FI boundary
- Closure of Hess and Strathcona
- 1 business case submission total of \$15.8 million (new school/demolition/site costs).





Staff Recommendation Rationale

- ✓ Improves learning environments for students
 ✓ JK-8 school
- ✓ French Immersion program in the North End
 ✓ Creates availability of FI in new location
 ✓ Helps alleviate enrolment pressures at EK and Ryerson
 ✓ New Facility within the community: approx. 600 pupil place





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Staff Recommendation Rationale

- ✓ New buildings will improve accessibility and energy efficiency
- ✓ Reduction of two facilities from inventory
- ✓ Reduction of \$5 million in renewal needs (includes all renewal)






Staff Recommendation (if no funding by Spring 2019)

If business case submissions are unsuccessful:

- Dr. Davey: Receives 95% of Hess students, Strathcona 5% of Hess students
- Introduction of FI at Bennetto
- Closure of Hess in June 2019.



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Staff Recommendation Rationale

- ✓ Improves learning environments
- ✓ Improved utilization: Dr Davey utilization improves from 62% to over 90% and Bennetto maintains its utilization with the addition of the FI program
- ✓ Reduction of one facility from inventory
- ✓ Reduction of \$2.5 million in renewal needs
