School Bus Safety Rules Please share with your child

ON THE WAY TO THE BUS

- Be alert, arrive at your stop at least five minutes early.
- Always obey all traffic lights and signals.
- Plan to walk with friends whenever possible,
- If you have to cross a street always cross at crosswalks and intersections.
- Always look both ways before crossing the street

- Stand back from the curb or where the bus stops
- Don't push or shove when entering or exiting and always use the steps and handrail.
- Always obey the bus drivers directions
- ♦ Do not play around the bus



WHEN ON THE BUS

- Take your seat quietly and quickly, remain seated when the bus is moving
- Keep your feet on the floor and never put your hands or any other object outside the window of the bus
- Talk in a quiet voice, be courteous to the driver and schoolmates.

Never distract the driver through misbehaviour on the bus.

Safe Footwear for Gym

While the warm weather is still with us, some students enjoy wearing sandal type shoes to school. Unfortunately, open-toed shoes are a safety concern during gym class so please have alternate footwear available. Running shoes provide better support and coverage for your child's feet and we encourage them to wear running shoes for all indoor and outdoor gym classes.

Playgrounds—Danger of Strangulation

Each year in Canada thousands of children get hurt on playgrounds playing on slides, monkey bars or swings. Some children have died when their clothing or drawstrings got caught on the playground fences or equipment and when they became entangled in ropes or skipping ropes attached to playground equipment. Loose clothing, hoods, scarves, drawstrings, mitten cords, ropes and skipping ropes can strangle a child.

When buying new clothing, for children, consider alternate closures to drawstrings such as elastics, buttons, velcro or snaps.

Safety Tips

- Remove cords and drawstrings from children's hoods and jackets or trim the exposed length to 8cm.
- Make sure any loose drawstring is free of knots, loops or toggles as they can get caught.
- Tuck in all clothing that can get caught on playground equipment.
- Wear a neck warmer instead of a scarf.
- Take off bicycle helmets before using playground

JK/SK Students Students will enter from the fenced playground, located at the front of the school. Staff

supervision is provided from 8:10 a.m. to 8:25 a.m. Parents and guardians/caregivers are asked

to drop off their child(ren) at the gate and not to enter the play area.

If it is raining or an extreme weather day, kindergarten students will enter as they normally do

and go to the gym.

Access to the parking lot for vehicles is prohibited during this time.

Grade 1-5 Students Students will enter from the rear playground, located behind the school. Staff supervision is

provided from 8:10 a.m. to bell time at 8:25 a.m.

If it is raining or an extreme weather day, students should go to the playground and enter the

school through the gym door.

Access to the parking lot for vehicles is prohibited during this time.

AFTERSCHOOL PICK-UP

JK/SK Students Kindergarten parents and guardians/caregivers are to pick up their child(ren) at the gate in the

front playground. Staff supervision is provided between 2:45 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Access to the parking lot for vehicles is prohibited during this time.

Grade 1-5 Students Students will be dismissed from school directly into the rear playground. Staff supervision is

provided between 2:45 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Access to the parking lot for vehicles is prohibited during this time.
