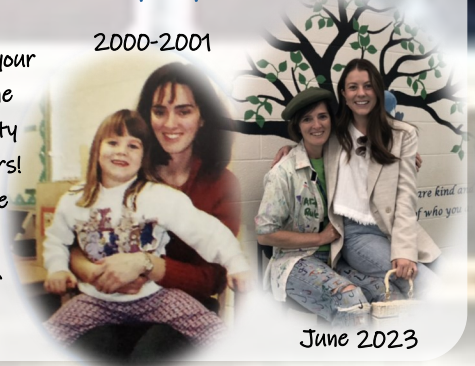
Elementary Class Placement Communication
