- Keep food distribution area clean, stocked and organized
- Participate in set-up/take-down procedures
- Adhere to Health and Safety Guidelines

### **Skills/Experience**

These are the qualifications that are necessary for someone to be considered for the position.

Qualifications include:

- Ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Dependability and committed to your scheduled shift
- Willingness to work in all weather conditions
- Must be physically able to carry up to 20lbs
- Ability to stand or walk for extended periods of time
- Ability to efficiently prepare and serve food items in a timely manner according to Health and Safety Guidelines

Must be 16+ or accompanied by an adult.

### **Working conditions**

You will report to Volunteer Headquarters for check-in each day *prior* to your shift. All shifts will be outdoors rain *or* shine.

- All shifts available
- Shifts normally run 3-4 hours in length
- Event is held on a weekend
