- 1. Students will circle choices on the Ancaster High Option Sheet. If you will NOT graduate by June 2017, use your Student Status Sheet to make sure you will meet graduation requirements next year!
- 2. Option Sheets must be signed by a parent/guardian if you are under 18, then returned to Student
- 3. FEES ALL school fees will be paid by "School Cash Online". Please follow the steps below to process the payment of your child's school fees:
  - a. You need to set this account up one time. You must set up a separate account for each child at Ancaster High School.

### HOW TO MAKE THE CORRECT CHOICES

- 1. A Course Selection Sheet must be returned by all Grade 12 students whether you are returning or not. Each student must also complete their Career Cruising Course input.
- Students who wish to return for a 5<sup>th</sup> year of high school should plan for 1 semester only. All students who wish to return should see their guidance counsellor to make a plan.
- 3. Returning students who will not graduate this June should review the status sheet to ensure they will meet their diploma requirements after their extra semester/year.
- 4. How to fill out the Ancaster High Option Sheet.
  - . If you are NOT RETURNING to Ancaster High, circle NOTRET and then circle where you intend to go next year - college, university, apprenticeship, or work.
  - If are returning for one semester only, then you must circle 3 or 4 course choices on the Ancaster High Option Sheet and circle NORET2 (for not returning semester 2).
  - Students wishing to return for semester 2 must see a Vice Principal in January 2018.

<u>FULL DISCLOSURE (Withdrawn & Repeated Courses)</u>
If a student withdraws from a grade 11 or grade 12 course after the Full Disclosure date (five instructional days following the mid-semester report card), the withdrawn course and current mark is recorded permanently on the transcript. Any repeated courses are recorded on the transcript. Please check the Ancaster High School website under Student Services for more information.



### What do I do with my option sheet?

If you are not returning:

- Put your name at the top of the front
- Circle NOTRETURNING (on the back)
- Circle where you plan to go (on the back)
- Sign/have a parent sign (on the back)
- Bring your option sheet back to guidance



### What do I do with my option sheet?

If you are returning:

- Put your name at the top (front of the page)
- Circle NOTRETURNING SEMESTER 2 (on back)
- Select 3 or 4 courses/credits
- Sign/have a parent sign (on back)
- Bring your option sheet back to guidance



### What must a post grad do?

- You will register for semester 1 only.
- You must register for a minimum of 3 courses
  - If you wish to attend for a morning only or an afternoon only, you will apply to do this in September
- If you wish to return for semester 2, you will apply for this in January.
- You must have a plan!

### **Online Courses**

- This year, students have the option of taking some courses online.
- On the options sheets these will have "@"
- Online courses are organized just like "in school" courses
  - There are set timelines
  - There are set due dates
  - Units will begin and end
  - There will be a culminating activity AND/OR an exam

Online courses are NOT self paced!
