- Write down your program choices and codes and keep them handy.




Step 3: Mark Your Calendar

- October/November 2021: Receive your access codes for the 101 application.
- January 13, 2022: Deadline to submit your completed application to the OUAC.
- May 27, 2022: Last day you can expect a response from an Ontario university if you applied by the January 13 deadline.
- June 1, 2022: The earliest day you may be required to respond to an offer and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration or residence deposit, etc.).
