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



Ancaster High School offers six special programs that add to your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). All begin in Grade 11 and require little to no preparation in Grade 9 and 10. They are:

   Specialist High Skills Majors (SHSM) in Hospitality & Tourism. Information & Communication, Manufacturing, Health & Wellness, and Arts &
- SPECIAL PROGRAMS SYSTEM WITH

HWDSB offers seven system programs at other schools and require applications and sometimes interviews/auditions. All begin in Grade 11. Please select the course code in Xello to alert your quidance counsellor to your interest and then make an appointment:

- 1. "Work in Progress" Program (HWWIPP) offers paid co-op for students who need help graduating
- ArtSmart (HWARTSM) offers specialized courses in drama, voice, instrumental, dance, and musical theatre
   Building Careers from the Ground Up (HWBUILD) provides courses in residential/commercial construction
- Building Careers from the Ground Up (HWBULD) provides courses in residential/commercial construction

#### Full Disclosure

- Applies to Grade 11 and 12 courses only
- Starting five days after mid-semester report cards, all courses in which a student is registered will be recorded on the transcript
- Courses that are dropped, failed, or repeated after this date will appear on your transcript
- Check post-secondary schools' policies

# ANCASTER CONTRA EST LUMBING

## Which Schools Consider Dropped, Failed, or Repeated Courses?

- It is the student's responsibility to research this and consider this before dropping or repeating a course
  - Usually, only universities consider this (not colleges)
- Most universities will consider only the attempt resulting in the highest grade
- We suggest reviewing University of Waterloo, University of Toronto, and McMaster University's policies on repeated courses

### Degree Programs (College & University)

- Universities mostly offer three and four-year degree programs, most also offer diplomas/certificates as supplemental qualifications
- Please remember that "colleges" also offer degree programs







# ANCASTER ACCOUNTAGEST LIMBERTS

### Pathway - University

- All Ontario universities require:
  - Six Grade 12 University-Level (4U) or Grade 12 University/College-Level (4M) courses
  - "6 4U/4M Courses"
- Most Ontario universities require that ENG4U1 is one of those six
- The "other five" requirements change from program to program and (less so) from university to university

# ANCASTER COZNITA EST LIMBING

### **University Application Process**

- Students start applying in November, 2023
- The due date is December 15, 2023
  - There are other deadlines for portfolios, supplemental information, and interviews in 2024
- In September, 2023 we will send the universities all Grade 11 marks and any completed Grade 12 marks from this year
  - This includes any course taken in July, 2023. Please make sure we get your report card!

# ANCASTER CONTARST LIMENTS

### **University Application Process**

- Some universities will extend an early offer of admission based on a combination of five 3U/3M or 4U/4M grades (if available) in required courses (i.e. English, Math, Physics, Chemistry, etc.)
- "Early" offers mean any time before May 2024!
- There is no advantage to having "more" 4U/4M final grades compared to 3U/3M final grades
- Final decisions arrive after Semester Two Mid-semester Grades
- Ultimately, decisions are based on final and mid-semester grades in six 4U/4M courses

- Start researching universities now
- Start looking at samples of non-academic requirements like essays, portfolios, interviews, etc.

# ANCASTER STANDARDS

### Pathways - College

- Colleges offer some degrees (same requirements as a university 6 4U/4M courses)
- Colleges mostly offer:
  - one year certificates
  - two-year diploma programs
  - three-year advanced diploma programs (these can lead to degrees)
- All diplomas require Grade 12 College-Level English (ENG4C1)

# ANCASTER STANGERS

### Pathways - College

- Students apply in November 2023
- Colleges use Grade 11 OR Grade 12 marks for admission
- If your Grade 12 English (ENG4C1) isn't until Semester Two next year, colleges will use your final grade in **Grade 11 English!**
- Offers of admission begin in February 2024 and continue until all spaces are full
- Some programs are HIGHLY competitive

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### Our Top Colleges

- 60 students accepted an offer to an Ontario college last year for a diploma or degree
- 33 of those students went to Mohawk in September 2022
- Others went to places like Conestoga, Humber, and Sheridan

# ANCASTER ANCASTER \*CONTAREST LIMERUS

### Pathways - Apprenticeship

- Apprentices must graduate high school
- Apprenticeships can only be acquired through sponsorship or employment by a person or company from the related trade
- High school co-op can lead to an apprenticeship
- Dual Credit opportunities at college can also lead to apprenticeship

# ANCASTER SOMETIME AND ANCASTER

### The One Course All Grade 12's Must Take

- All Grade 12 students require a fourth English credit
- If you have failed a compulsory Semester One class, please re-take this in Grade 12 (English or Math)
  - Please choose this even if you plan to attend summer school
  - Once you register for summer school, we will replace the failed class with an elective
- Students should choose any remaining Group 1, 2, or 3 compulsory credit

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# ANCASTER ANCASTER

#### **Electives**

- Must have a Grade 11 Arts credit to take a Grade 12 Arts (Visual Arts or Dramatic Arts)
- Must have a Grade 11 Music credit to take Grade 12 Music (Instrumental or Repertoire)
- Must have Grade 11 French to take this in Grade 12
- All Grade 12 Technology courses require a pre-requisite from Grade 11



- Become ready for a successful transition to college

**TRY COLLEGE FOR FREE!** -- No cost for transportation, textbooks, or course materials.

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#### Who is Eligible to Participate?

#### **Grade 11 and 12 Students are eligible to participate if:**

- They have not yet graduated (\*post-graduates <u>are not</u> eligible)
- Completed most, or all, of their compulsory credits
- Have had some success in college preparation courses
- Could benefit from a college pathway experience
- Has the potential to succeed and is ready to focus on reaching their full academic potential

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## ANCASTER ANCASTER

#### e-Learning

- Many courses are offered via e-Learning (check Xello)
- Some courses are offered "e-Learning only"
- e-Learning classes are NOT easier and are NOT self-paced
  - The curriculum follows the same pace as regular classes
  - There are due dates throughout the course
  - Units will and end and the curriculum will be locked
  - There will be a culminating activity and/or exam

## ANCASTER SOLENTA EST LIBERTS

#### **Summer School**

- Students self-register for summer school and guidance counsellors double check and approve
  - Students must also notify us which course they'd like to take to replace the summer school course
- Courses lasts all of July and might have an exam
- Courses are usually offered in-class and via e-Learning
- There are very few electives mostly English, Math, and Science

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#### **Early Offers**

A marketing strategy used only by universities

• If universities see this year's 3U/3M (maybe 4U/4M) grades were comfortably higher than estimated admission average for September 2024, you may receive an early offer

 Never offered for programs that require an audition, portfolio, special testing, or extensive supplemental information

## ANCASTER STEAMENTS

#### Three Rounds of Offers

- Round 1 (December 2023)
  - Grade 11 marks including any Grade 12 4U/4M courses that you may have completed early
  - We now send semester-one mid-semester grades to the universities
  - This year, schools did not use these grades to help determine offers
- Round 2 (March 2024)
  - Semester One final grades and some Grade 11 marks
  - This is the round usually referred to as "early offer"
- Final Offers (May 2024)
  - Semester One final and Semester Two mid-semester grades

# ANCASTER STUBBLES

#### How University Offers Work

- A university might receive 9000 applications for 600 seats.
- Students will apply with averages in the 70's, 80's and 90's
- A program having 600 spaces means the school will dispense 1000 offers (they predict 400 students will say "no")
- Therefore, an average of "85%" across six 4U/4M courses is used because only 1000 students had an average this high

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#### How College Offers Work

#### **SCENARIO 1**

A program has 85 seats and 60 students apply - everyone is admitted!

#### **SCENARIO 2**

- A program has 100 seats and 2000 students apply
- Only students with minimum grade of "75%" in English are given an initial offer
- If any of those students say "no" the college moves down the list (i.e. "74%", then "73%", etc.)
- Some colleges use an average of grades in required courses
