Ontario Diploma

- 30 Credits
 - usually over 5 years for OHL players
 - two e-Learning courses (can opt out)
- 40 Hours of Community Involvement
 - easily reached with the Bulldogs' various charitable activities
- Literacy Test
 - written in Grade 10 before players join the OHL





2023-2024 Learning Model

- 100% e-Learning
- Players enrolled at Ancaster High School full time for a minimum of 3 e-Learning courses per semester
- Daily time allocated for school
- Supervised daily by staff
- Education support on-stie by Steve Giftopoulos & across the street at Ancaster High School





e-Learning

- e-Learning is not self-paced
- Follows the same pacing as a semestered day-school classroom (September – January & February – June)
- Each course is taught by a certified Ontario teacher employed by a public or catholic school board





Player Expectations

- Logging in daily to all three courses via The Hub
- Maintaining Level 3 grades
- Course support:
 - Course teacher
 - 2. Online tutoring



- 3. Mr. Giftopoulos on-site and Mr. Nicholson at Ancaster High or e-mail
- Volunteer teacher tutoring and Peer tutoring can be arranged

Transitioning Back to Home School

College and University







- The team has established partnerships with Mohawk College and McMaster University in Hamilton
- Athabasca University is preferred by the Bulldogs and around the league for its quality and flexibility





Receiving an Offer of Admission

- Colleges use **minimum grades** (i.e. 70% in English) or an average
- Universities uses an average over six 4U/4M courses (i.e. 80% average in ENG4U1 plus required courses)
- Schools offer special consideration to the Bulldogs' rigorous hockey schedule but we don't recommend this model
- Most players apply as mature students and don't need all six 4U/4M
- Pursuing an apprenticeship is challenging after OHL life but possible
