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SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION & RULES FOR JULY 2023

HWDSB's Continuing Education department (CE) has announced e-Learning-only summer school for July 2023 and a maximum of **one course only** (Civics & Careers count as one course).

NOTE: About 1 in 3 students register for summer school. Approving each registration and then changing next year's timetable takes a significant amount of time. PLEASE READ THE LIST OF CAUTIONS/RULES BEFORE REGISTERING:

CAUTIONS

- CAUTION: Taking a summer school course does not guarantee your choice of replacement course (Ex: Taking Gr. 11 Biology in summer school doesn't guarantee Gr. 12 Biology next year)
- 2. DEADLINE: The deadline to pre-register your summer school plans was April 10th. We have extended the deadline to May 1st.
- CAUTION: Students who have pre-registered by May 1st are more likely to get their replacement course (the course they made room for by going to summer school). Students who pre-register for summer school after May 1st are less likely to get their replacement course.
- 4. RULE: Students are not allowed to take summer school in exchange for a study period the year after unless they have accumulated 24 credits. This means that most current Grade 9's and 10's will not be allowed study periods next year.
- 5. **CAUTION**: some post-secondary institutions do not favour high school credits completed via summer school.
- 6. **CAUTION**: achievement data indicates that learning via summer school may be inadequate preparation for other courses.
- 7. **CAUTION**: Ancaster High School's math and science departments do not recommend summer school for the first attempt of a course. Repeats are okay.
- 8. **CAUTION**: our data indicates that students who reach ahead and take Grade 12 courses in Grade 11 (and Grade 11 courses in Grade 10) are less successful.
- 9. CAUTION: students who attempt to reach ahead will not be allowed to change their reach-ahead course past a certain point in the semester (*Ex: A grade 11 student attempting Grade 12 Biology and not being successful will not be allowed to drop this or take another course*).
- 10. **CAUTION**: students will not be allowed to drop a course due to a lack of achievement and then register for the same course next year (*Ex: A grade 11 students not having success in Gr. 12 Physics cannot drop this course and try again in Grade 12*).
- 11. **RULE**: Dropping a class due to a lack of achievement is not allowed. We will encourage improved learning skills, conferencing with the teacher, peer tutoring, etc.

- 12. **CAUTION**: students seeking high achievement/high grades have the most potential in face-to-face classes (summer school is e-Learning only).
- 13. **PLAN CAREFULLY**: Students seeking high achievement/high grades need to plan carefully. Reaching ahead/fast tracking 4U/4M courses in grade 10 and 11 generally results in unsatisfactory results.
 - a. We recommend having very strong preparation in grade 9, 10, and 11 before taking 4U/4M courses.
 - b. Properly prepared students who pace themselves have the best results.
- 14. **PREPARE**: Our data indicates that poor preparation in Grade 10 leads to poor performance in Grade 11. We recommend **repeating** a course with an unsatisfactory grade before moving on to the next level (*Ex: A final grade of 50% in Gr. 10 Math does not indicate good results in Gr. 11 Math. We recommend repeating Gr. 10 Math*).
- ENSURE your parents/guardians acknowledge the risks associated with summer school, reaching ahead to take Grade 12 courses in Grade 11 (and Grade 11 courses in Grade 10), e-Learning, and not being properly prepared for 4U/4M courses.
- 16. **MYTH: universities will not offer you admission "earlier" for having more 4U/4M courses prior to grade 12.** If a university wants to extend an early offer to highly qualified applicants, they use final grades in 3U/3M courses (including required courses). Ultimately, final offers depend on an admission average using ENG4U1, plus five more 4U/4M courses (including required courses).
