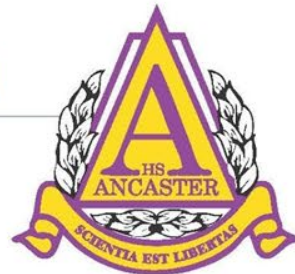

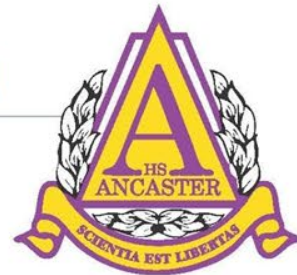

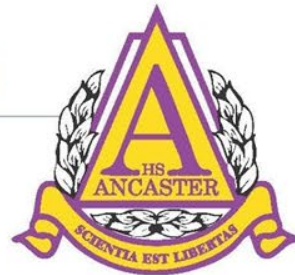
Full Disclosure

- Applies to Grade 11 and 12 courses only
- Starting **five days after mid-semester report cards**, all courses in which a student is registered will be recorded on the transcript
- Courses that are dropped, failed, or repeated after this date will appear on your transcript
- Check post-secondary schools' policies



Which Schools Consider Dropped, Failed, or Repeated Courses?

- It is the student's responsibility to research this and consider this before dropping or repeating a course
 - Usually, only universities consider this (not colleges)
- **Most universities will consider only the attempt resulting in the highest grade**
- We suggest reviewing University of Waterloo, University of Toronto, and McMaster University's policies on repeated courses



College/University Applications

- Continue to monitor your applications for offers of admission
 - Check your e-mail, each school's student portal (McMaster's is called Mosaic, Mohawk's is called "My Mohawk"), OUAC, and OCAS
- Check OCAS and OUAC to ensure:
 - Last semester's courses are uploaded with the correct mark
 - Current semester's courses are uploaded, especially private school courses
 - All required courses for admission are there
- OUAC - make sure it reads "You will achieve OSSD"

 - Student Profile Form (Guelph)?
 - Personal Statement of Experience (Queen's)?
 - Portfolios
 - Competency/Aptitude tests like CASPer

Pathway - University

- All offers of admission are conditional
- Admission averages will be recalculated in July, 2024 after final grades are received
- Universities will rescind offers of admission if conditions are not met
- Scholarships might be based on final admission averages



Offers of Admission

- Some offers have already been dispensed
- Round Two offers continue until the end of March
- Universities just received Semester One final grades!
- Regular offers begin in May once mid-semester grades are received
- All universities must respond by May 29, 2024
- Students must respond to offers by June 1, 2024



May 29, 2024

The latest date all current Ontario high school students who submitted their application by the January application deadline can expect a response from an Ontario university. This includes an offer of admission, a refusal or a deferral, once additional information is received.



June 3, 2024

The earliest date a current Ontario high school student may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).

All other admission-related elements, including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence, are considered part of the offer of admission. Therefore, a student may accept these other offers before June 3, 2024, but Ontario universities will not compel a student in any way to make a decision before this date.



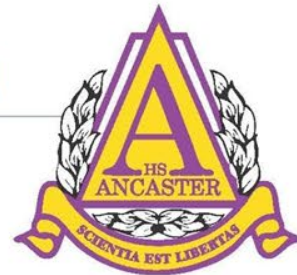
Pathway - College

- Some offers of admission began after the application fee was paid, the majority on February 1, 2024
- Offers will continue on a “rolling basis”
- Students not accepted into a program will be placed on a waitlist – this will be updated after mid-semester grades are received



Residence (College & University)

- Universities will have deadlines for applications for residence
- Colleges may request that students apply for residence early as spaces fill up quickly

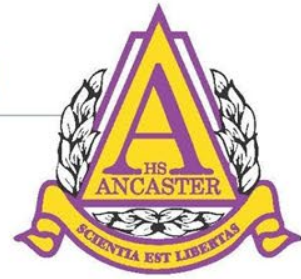
- Begin O.S.A.P. applications in the spring using the OSAP estimator

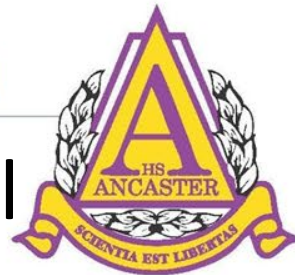
Year Five Agreement Due March 1

- You must follow the Code of Conduct for the school and model good behaviour

SPECIAL PROGRAMS – ANCASTER HIGH

Ancaster High School offers six special programs that add to your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). All begin in Grade 11 and require little to no preparation in Grade 9 and 10. They are:

- **International Baccalaureate Diploma Program** (e-mail Mr. Taylor at dtaylor@hwdsb.on.ca). This requires FSF2D1 & MCR3U1 in Grade 10.
- **Specialist High Skills Majors (SHSM)** in Hospitality & Tourism, Information & Communication, Manufacturing, Health & Wellness, and Arts & Culture. Please see back of page for a summary of required courses.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS – SYSTEM WIDE

HWDSB offers seven system programs at other schools and require applications and sometimes interviews/auditions. All begin in Grade 11. Please select the course code in Xello to alert your guidance counsellor of your interest and then make an appointment:

1. **"Work in Progress" Program (HWWIPP)** offers paid co-op for students who need help graduating
2. **ArtSmart (HWARTSM)** offers specialized courses in drama, voice, instrumental, dance, and musical theatre
3. **Building Careers from the Ground Up (HWWBULD)** provides courses in residential/commercial construction
4. **Canadian Forces Co-op Program (HWCDF)** enrolls students in the Canadian Forces (militia) for one semester
5. **Healthcare Support Services Program (HWHCAL)** teaches students clinical/support skills in a simulated hospital ward setting
6. **Mohawk College Dual Credits (HWMCDL)** offers students a half-day at Mohawk College in college courses that also count for high school
7. **Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program – Accelerated OYAP (HWOYAPA)** offers students with co-op placements Level One training

Remember Timetable Changes?

- While it's fresh...
- Since March 2023, guidance counsellors made about 1000 timetable changes to both semester one and two classes
- Since January 25th, guidance counsellors made over 200 timetable changes...just for semester two!
- Many students requested multiple changes...and some asked us to reverse the change we already made!
- Remember how full classes were? E-Learning too?
- Please plan carefully for Year Five – this will help you and us!



Please Choose Carefully

- Course choices are due in Xello by March 1st
- You (if over 18) or your parents/guardians are asked to verify those choices in Parent Portal from March 11-22 and notify us of changes that are needed
- Starting March 23, the Board uses Xello data to decide exactly how many courses we can have at Ancaster High. **This number won't change** and so **we** can't change and so...**you** can't change!
 - We always try our best to support students with a plan to help them pursue post-secondary (apprenticeship, college, university)
- Ask for help/advice: older siblings, teachers, coaches, guidance counsellors



e-Learning Courses at HWDSB

- Nearly every course offered in-person at Ancaster High School is also offered via e-Learning
- e-Learning offers some unique options NOT offered here at Ancaster High, *like NAC20 - First Nations, Métis, and Inuit in Canada*

e-Learning has Class Maximums Too!

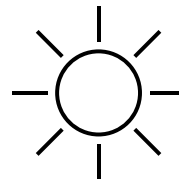
- Remember – all e-Learning must be chosen by March 1st

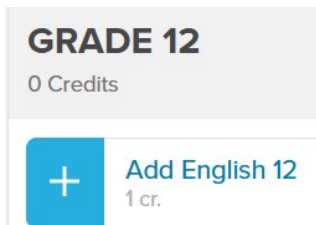

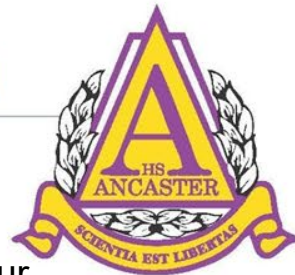


Summer School ****NEW****

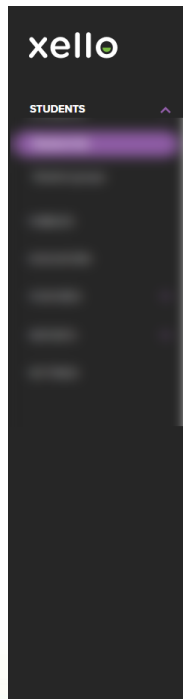

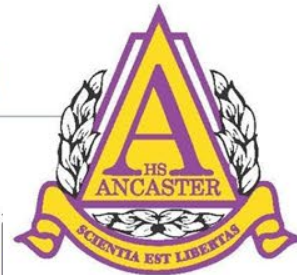

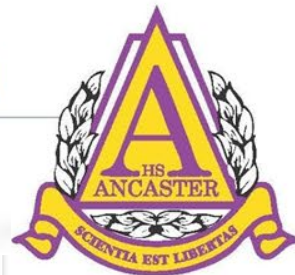
