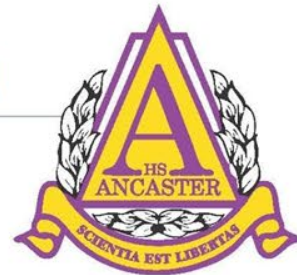
# Remember Timetable Changes?

- While it's fresh...
- Since March 2023, guidance counsellors made about 1000 timetable changes to both semester one and two classes
- Since January 25<sup>th</sup>, guidance counsellors made over 200 timetable changes...just for semester two!
- Many students requested multiple changes...and some asked us to reverse the change we already made!
- Remember how full classes were? E-Learning too?
- Please plan carefully for next year – this will help you and us!



# Please Choose Carefully

- Course choices are due in Xello by March 1<sup>st</sup>
- Your parents/guardians are asked to verify those choices in Parent Portal from March 11-22 and notify us of changes that are needed
- Starting March 23, the Board uses Xello data to decide exactly how many courses we can have at Ancaster High. **This number won't change** and so **we** can't change and so...**you** can't change!
  - We always try our best to support students with a plan to help them graduate and pursue post-secondary (apprenticeship, college, university)
- Ask for help/advice: older siblings, teachers, coaches, guidance counsellors

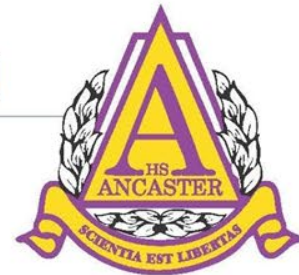

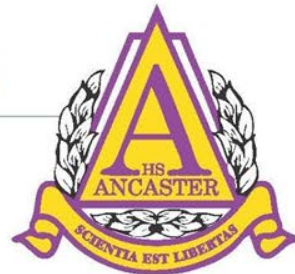

Courses on this document are offered in-person. Most are also offered via e-Learning. Students choose preference in Xello. Some courses not listed here are offered ONLY via e-Learning. Students find e-Learning-only courses in Xello under the e-Learning discipline.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS – ANCASTER HIGH

Ancaster High School offers six special programs that add to your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). All begin in Grade 11 and require little to no preparation in Grade 9 and 10. They are:

- International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (e-mail Mr. Taylor at [dtaylor@hwdsb.on.ca](mailto:dtaylor@hwdsb.on.ca)). This requires FSF2D1 & MCR3U1 in Grade 10.
- Specialist High Skills Majors (SHSM) in Hospitality & Tourism, Information & Communication, Manufacturing, Health & Wellness, and Arts & Culture. Please see back of page for a summary of required courses

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS – SYSTEM WIDE

HWDSB offers seven system programs at other schools and require applications and sometimes interviews/auditions. All begin in Grade 11. Please select the course code in Xello to alert your guidance counsellor to your interest and then make an appointment:

1. "Work in Progress" Program (HWWIPP) offers paid co-op for students who need help graduating
2. ArtSmart (HAWARTSM) offers specialized courses in drama, voice, instrumental, dance, and musical theatre
3. Building Careers from the Ground Up (HBBUILD) provides courses in residential/commercial construction
4. Canadian Forces Co-op Program (HWCDF) enrolls students in the Canadian Forces (militia) for one semester
5. Healthcare Support Services Program (HWHSEAL) teaches students clinical support skills in a simulated hospital ward setting
6. Mohawk College Dual Credits (HWMDCD) offers students a half-day at Mohawk College in college courses that also count for high school
7. Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program – Accelerated OYAP (HWOYAPA) offers students with co-op placements Level One training

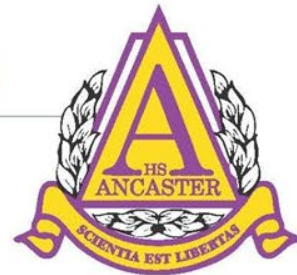

# e-Learning has Class Maximums Too!

- Remember – all e-Learning must be chosen by March 1<sup>st</sup>
- After March 22 (the end of Parent Portal course verification), we cannot guarantee e-Learning to anyone who asks to change a class from in-person to e-Learning
- Every e-Learning course is taught by a teacher in a high school somewhere in Ontario and has a class size maximum
- We cannot make more room in e-Learning
- So...if you want e-Learning in grade 10 – please choose it in Xello by March 1<sup>st</sup>!

- Students should choose academic or applied based on **pathway plan**

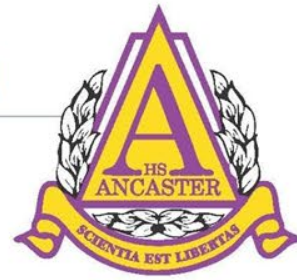

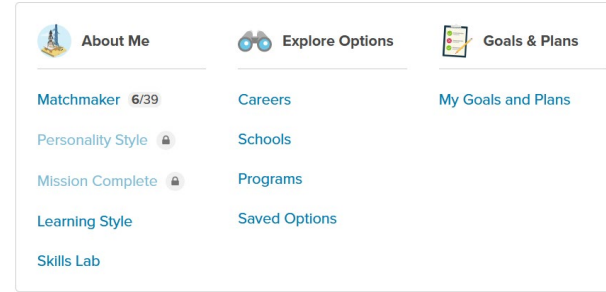
## ENG2D1 versus ENG2P1

- The English you choose is the most important
- All **degree** programs in Ontario require a pathway that includes **ENG2D1 (Academic English)**. Degrees are offered at colleges and universities
- All **diploma** programs in Ontario require a pathway that includes ENG2D1 (Academic English) or **ENG2P1 (Applied English)**
- Choose carefully

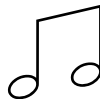
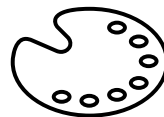

# Choosing Three Electives

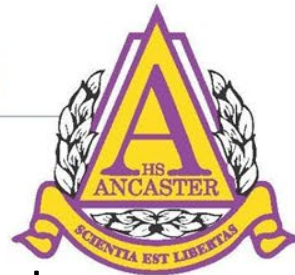
- Usually need a Grade 9 or 10 **Arts** credit to take Grade 11 **Arts** (Visual Arts or Dramatic Arts) *except*
  - *AVI301 (Gr 11 Visual Art – Open Level) or*
  - *ADB301 (Gr 11 Musical Theatre – Open Level)*
- Must have a Grade 9 or 10 **Music** credit to take Grade 11 **Music** (Instrumental or Repertoire)
- Must have a Grade 10/Level 1 **Language** (French or Spanish) to take these in Grade 11/Level 2





# Things to Remember

- Finish Group 1, Group 2, and Group 3 credits in Grade 10 or 11
  - Group 1: Language, Social Science, Canadian & World History, Co-op, etc.
  - Group 2: Physical Education, Business, Arts, Co-op, etc.
  - Group 3: Science, Technology, Co-op, etc.
  
- Choosing Grade 11 courses in Grade 10
  - No need to “get ahead” by taking Grade 11 courses
  - Some students planning to take Calculus & Vectors in Grade 12 might choose to take two Math credits in Grade 11 (*MCR3U1* & *MHF4U1*)



# Choices in Grade 10

- Some students decide on Grade 11 University courses too early
- Students have success in Grade 11 University courses most often after achieving Level 3 grades in Grade 10 Academic courses
- We recommend students take the time to see how they do in Grade 10 Academic courses before selecting University courses
- Our advice: save Grade 11 courses for Grade 11!

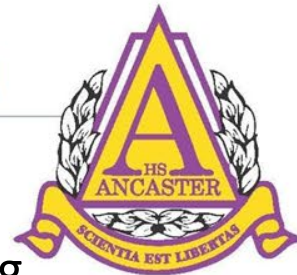

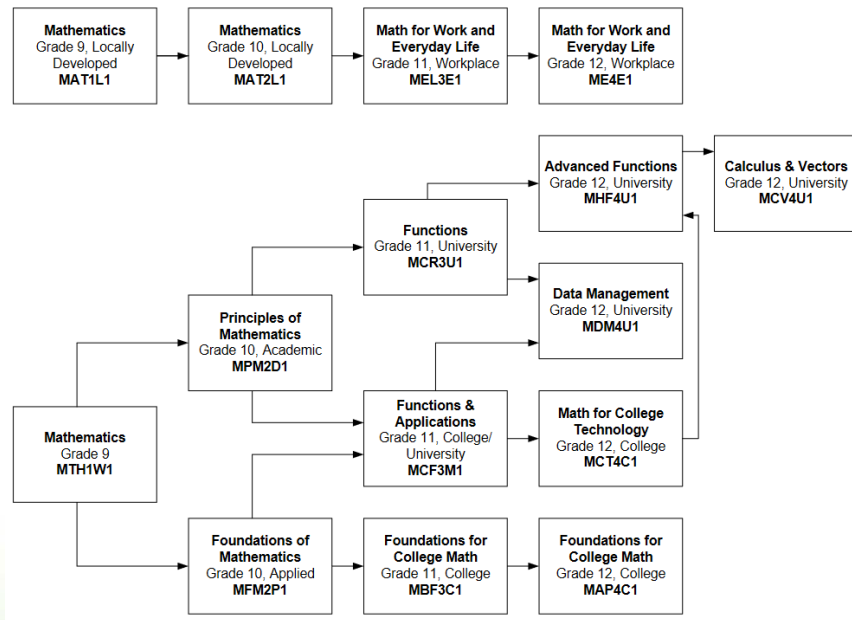
# MCR3U1 - Functions

- We recommend that students consider multiple careers and multiple pathways
- This requires a lot of planning and thought
- Please don't choose MCR3U1 "automatically" as the default math after Grade 10
- This course is designed for students pursuing degrees in things like Engineering, Accounting, Kinesiology, etc.
- This course demands excellent learning skills and includes a lot of higher-order thinking
- Please consider our advice in the next slides

- MFM2P1 (Grade 10 Applied) is needed for MBF3C1 or MCF3M1
- MPM2D1 (Grade 10 Academic) is needed for MCR3U1

## MCF3M1 – Functions & Applications

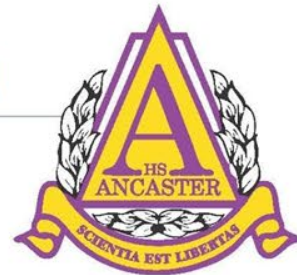
- Expands on ideas from Grade 10 Academic & Applied Math
- Students recognize the concepts and are familiar with the type of thinking needed to be successful
- This course might be sufficient for our diploma-bound (college) and degree-bound (college or university) students
- *Example: Nurses: this could be all you need...maybe MDM4U1 too!*
- Consider taking MCF3M1 first and then MCR3U1

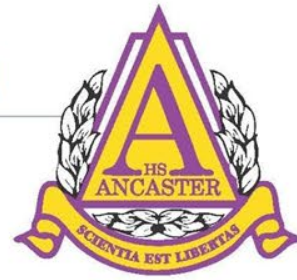
## Math and Apprenticeship/Workplace

- Any level of Grade 10 Math is okay for an apprenticeship
- Grade 10 Applied (MFM2P1) is recommended
- For future Electricians...more Math is better!

### I.B. (International Baccalaureate Diploma Program)

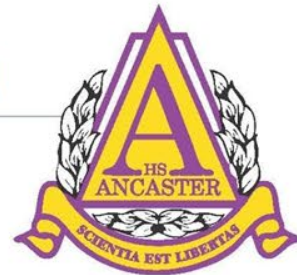
- Starts in Grade 11 and students get two diplomas (OSSD and IB)
- Interested students should contact Mr. Taylor, the I.B. Coordinator (dtaylor@hwdsb.on.ca) with questions
- If interested, Grade 10 students should take:
  - MCR3U1 in semester two or in July 2025 (summer school)
  - We recommend students take FSF2D1 too
- I.B. students don't have room for Art, Physics, Computer Science, or Tech Design and should take these courses in Grade 10 or summer school if available





## Looking Ahead to Post-Secondary

- Future apprentices should take lots of Co-op, starting in Grade 11
- Students heading into diploma programs (College) should check [www.ontariocolleges.ca](http://www.ontariocolleges.ca) for the types of courses they should be taking in high school
- Students heading into degree programs (College and University) should check [www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca](http://www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca) for their program's required courses

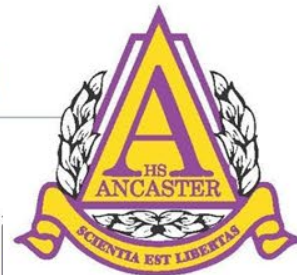

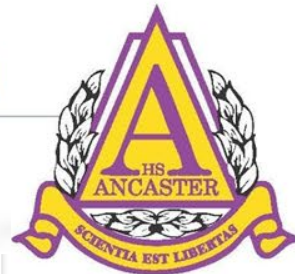
