### SPECIAL PROGRAMS – ANCASTER HIGH

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS – SYSTEM WIDE

HWDSB offers **seven system programs** that require applications and sometimes interviews/auditions. **All begin in Grade 11**. Please select the course code in myBlueprint to alert your guidance counsellor of your interest.

1. **ArtSmart** offers specialized courses in drama, voice, instrumental, dance, and musical theatre
2. **Building Careers from the Ground Up** provides courses in residential/commercial construction
3. **Canadian Forces Co-op Program** enrolls students in the Canadian Forces for one semester
4. **Healthcare Support Services Program** teaches students clinical/support skills in a simulated hospital ward setting
5. **Mohawk College Dual Credits** offers students a half-day at Mohawk College in college courses that also count for high school
6. **Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program – Accelerated OYAP** offers students already sponsored with Level One training
7. **Steps to Graduation or “S2G”** offers paid co-op positions in the community for students who need extra support to graduate

**SPECIALIST HIGH SKILLS MAJORS** (*Students are eligible for one only*)

These programs begin in Grade 11. Students must take a two-credit co-op and choose one course from each of the three columns in the corresponding SHSM and then choose two more from the 11 Major or 12 Major column. ***Example – Arts & Culture students might choose: ADA3M1, ADA4M1, BAF3M1 and then go back and choose AVI3M1 and TGJ4M1 in addition to a two-credit co-op over two years of high school (Gr 11 & 12).***
