

Full Disclosure

- Applies to Grade 11 and 12 courses only
- Starting five days after mid-semester report cards, all courses in which a student is registered will be recorded on the transcript
- Courses that are dropped, failed, or repeated after this date will appear on your transcript
- Check post-secondary schools' policies

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Which Schools Consider Dropped, Failed, or Repeated Courses?

- It is the student's responsibility to research this and consider this before dropping or repeating a course
 - Usually, only universities consider this (not colleges)
- Most universities will consider only the attempt resulting in the highest grade
- Some schools insist on using the most RECENT attempt, even if the grade is lower than the first attempt (it happens!)
- We suggest reviewing the University of Waterloo, University of Toronto, and Wilfrid Laurier's policies

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College/University Applications

- Continue to monitor your applications for offers of admission
 - Check your e-mail, each school's student portal (McMaster's is called Mosaic, Mohawk's is called "My Mohawk"), OUAC, and OCAS
- Check OCAS and OUAC to ensure:
 - Last semester's courses are uploaded with the correct mark
 - Current semester's courses are uploaded, especially private school courses
 - All required courses for admission are there
- OUAC make sure it reads "You will achieve OSSD"

 - Student Profile Form (Guelph)?
 - Personal Statement of Experience (Queen's)?
 - Portfolios
 - Competency/Aptitude tests like CASPer
 - HOAE Health Occupation Aptitude Exam?

- Accepting offers
- Residence applications

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Pathway - University

- All offers of admission are conditional
- Admission averages will be recalculated in July 2025 after final grades are received
- Universities will rescind offers of admission if conditions are not met
- Scholarships might be based on final admission averages

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Offers of Admission

- Some offers have already been dispensed
- Round Two offers continue until the end of March
- Universities just received Semester One final grades!
- Regular offers begin in May once mid-semester grades are received
- All universities must respond by May 29, 2025
- Students must respond to offers by June 2, 2025

May 29, 2025

The latest date all Group A applicants who submitted their application by the January application deadline can expect a response from an Ontario university. This includes an offer of admission, a refusal or a deferral, once additional information is received.

June 2, 2025

The earliest date a Group A applicant may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit).

All other admission-related elements, including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence, are considered part of the offer of admission. Therefore, a student may accept these other offers before June 2, 2025, but Ontario universities will not compel a student in any way to make a decision before this date.

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Our Most Popular Universities

Last year, 158 students accepted an offer to university. McMaster University was Ancaster High's most popular university that year with 50 confirmed offers for September 2024

Pathway - College

 Some offers of admission began after the application fee was paid, the majority on February 1, 2025

Offers will continue on a "rolling basis"

 Students not accepted into a program will be placed on a waitlist – this will be updated after mid-semester grades are received

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Residence (College & University)

Universities will have deadlines for applications for residence

 Colleges may request that students apply for residence early as spaces fill up quickly

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Financial Aid

Begin O.S.A.P. applications in the spring using the OSAP estimator





Need More Time to Graduate?



- Please make an appointment to see your guidance counsellor
- In myBlueprint, please enter:
 - NORET 2 and 4 courses + 1 alternate (if you only need one more semester to graduate). We will let you drop 1 course later, but you must keep at least 3

<u>OR</u>

• 6 courses, STUDY1 + STUDY2 + 1 alternate (you are not allowed to be part time and must take 3 courses per semester)

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Graduating in June, Want to Return



- NORET2 and 3 courses + 1 STUDY1 + 1 Alternate, OR
- NORET2 and 4 courses + 1 Alternate (Recommended)
 - One of your courses might be offered in semester two only or you might have a conflict
 - Choosing 4 courses tells us what else you might want
- Ask the Principal/Vice-Principal in December
 2025 about semester two

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 Pick exactly the courses you want by the February 25 deadline




All students choose 8 courses and one alternate course just in case we can't offer an elective course to you.

If you're taking an important course in summer school, myBlueprint might ask you to submit your courses with an error and leave us a note.

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



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Year Five Agreement for June Graduates

By returning, students are agreeing to the following:

- Year five is for improving academics and students must be **full-time** (3 or 4 courses)
- Students must have excellent attendance and follow attendance policies
- AHS has permission to share information with your guardians, even if you're 18
- If you're playing on a school sports team/extra-curriculars, you must be making good progress in academics and have excellent attendance
- You must follow the Code of Conduct for the school and model good behaviour

Remember Timetable Changes?

- While it's fresh...
- Since March 2024, guidance counsellors made nearly 1000 timetable changes to both semester one and two classes
- Since January 20th, guidance counsellors made over 250 timetable changes...just for semester two!
- Many students requested multiple changes...and some asked us to reverse the change we already made!
- Remember how full classes were? E-Learning too?
- Please plan carefully for Year Five this will help you and us!





Please Choose Carefully

- Course choices are due in myBlueprint by February 25 at 3 p.m.
- You (if over 18) or your parents/guardians are asked to verify those choices in Parent Portal (web version only) from March 3-7 and notify us of changes that are needed
- Starting March 1, the Board <u>uses myBlueprint data</u> to decide exactly how many courses we can have at Ancaster High. **This** number won't change and so we can't change and so...you can't change!
 - We always try our best to support students with a plan to help them pursue post-secondary (apprenticeship, college, university)
- Ask for help/advice: older siblings, teachers, coaches, guidance counsellors iosity


e-Learning Courses at HWDSB




- Nearly every course offered in-person at Ancaster High School is also offered via e-Learning

- Be careful when choosing "regular" courses. Look for the "eL"










e-Learning has Class Maximums Too!



- Remember all e-Learning must be chosen by March 1st
- After March 22, 2024 (the end of Parent Portal course verification), we cannot guarantee e-Learning to anyone who asks to change a class from in-person to e-Learning
- Every e-Learning course is taught by a teacher in a high school somewhere in Ontario and has a class size maximum
- We cannot make more room in e-Learning
- So...if you want e-Learning in grade 11 please choose it in Xello by March 1st!

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
