Student Registration	The school cannot accept new registrations for in-person school. All

Parent Access to School	Access to the school is very limited for parents, volunteers and visitors.

	school to speak with a staff member.
	When an in-person visit is required, the visitor must wear the
	medical mask provided by the office while in the school.

Bus loading and unloading	School busses will unload at: front of school (no change)
	School busses will load at: front of school (no change)
	A change in procedure is that students will walk down the side alley
	to the back of school when arriving. Students will have a designated
	location in the alley to gather before boarding.
School Parking Lot	Active transportation (walk/bike) is encouraged to reduce the
	amount of traffic at the start/end of the day.
	As in past years, the front parking lot will be closed at pick up and
	drop off times.

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	Parents driving their children to school are encouraged to drop and walk at a location near to the school.
	Families are encouraged to use the Meadowlands park area for parking and entering and exiting the rear school yard.
	The front of school should be used for bus students and
	Kindergarten as much as possible.
	The map of area parking and walking routes has been updated for this year and is posted separately.
	Please respect all local parking bylaws
Entry and Exit for Students	Parents are asked to drop their children off no earlier than 8:45am. The bell rings at 9:00am.
	When students enter the school yard, they are to proceed directly to their designated class location (marked) and line up.
	The designated class locations are for students only, parents cannot wait in these areas. There are designated areas on the property where parents can wait.
	Students/parents must physically distance (2m) from other families/staff while on school property
	Adults must wear face coverings while on school property.
	At the end of the day, students K – Gr. 3 will be dismissed directly to parents (or older siblings) from their outdoor designated class location. Kindergarten parents directly at the Kindergarten fenced area. Gr 1-3 visual contact with teacher from parent waiting area.
	Upon dismissal, students and families must leave school property in a timely fashion.
	An initial map of the school waiting areas is provided with this post.  Maps with specific class waiting areas identified will be shared before Sept 14.
Movement Around the School	Students will remain with their class cohort throughout the day.
	When in the school building, students remain in their classrooms throughout the day.
	Subject specific teachers will travel to classes to provide instruction.

	When moving about the school, students/classes will walk on the right side, maintaining physical distancing.
	Inside the school, students must wear a mask at all times.
	Students will hand wash/ sanitize when entering and exiting the classroom.
	Teachers will utilize outdoor instructional time to allow for mask-free time during the school day.
Student Belongings	Students will keep work materials at their desks in an individual container or desk.
	Lockers and hallway hooks will not be used. All student belongings must be stored in the classroom.
	Space is limited and students should only bring belongings that are absolutely necessary.
	School items should not go back and forth between home and school. Digital communication and resources will be promoted for home use.
	There is no lost and found.
Class Set Up	A sink or hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms.
	Each student is assigned a work-space area
	All desks are forward facing
	All required work materials are located at student's workspace (not to be shared with other students)
	There will be minimized use of shared materials. These must be cleaned before use by another student
FDK	Information regarding JK Orientation will be posted separately.
	Families will be asked to drop off and pick up students at the outdoor Kindergarten play area.
	Adults must physically distance and wear a mask on school property.
	Kindergarten students will stay with their designated class upon entry to the Kindergarten play area.

Use of the play area will be staggered throughout the school day to allow for single class use.
Physical Education Where possible, PE will take place outdoors.
Classes may be held in the gym only when necessary with cleaning of high touchpoints between classes.
Changerooms are closed. Students should wear clothes to school that are appropriate for physical activity.
There is no sharing of equipment between class cohorts. Each class will have their own equipment. Within a class cohort, students can play with the same equipment but will wash/ sanitize hands afterwards.
Music
No use of woodwind/brass instruments
Singing takes place outdoors only
Learning Commons Learning Commons will not used by classes/students (no book exchange).
A process for in-class use of books will be developed.
The school will continue with having half the students have lunch and half the students recess for Nutrition Breaks. At Ancaster Meadow, this is similar to past years.
Students eat in their classrooms at their desk.
Masks can be removed for eating only and then should be put back on. They will be stored in a provided paper bag while eating.
No sharing of food or beverages.
Each class has a designated outdoor play area separate from other classes.
Outdoor play spaces have been marked with duct tape and spray paint.
Students may remove masks during outdoor play.
The play structure will be closed during this time.

Washroom Use	Students will use washrooms closest to their classrooms.
	Occupancy limits will be posted outside washrooms.

	Students maintain physical distancing while in washrooms.
	Urinals and stalls: every other one marked off.
	Students may use hand dryers or paper towels.
	Students will always wash and/or sanitize their hands on returning
	to the classroom.
Hydration Stations	Water fountains have been closed. They cannot be used for direct
	drinking. The function to fill a water bottle is still available.
	Students use Hydration Station to fill labelled water bettle

	Students need to bring a labeled water bottle from home.

Clubs and Extracurriculars	Most clubs and extracurriculars will not be running at this time.
	Cohorts will not be combined for extracurriculars
	Clubs and extracurriculars may only take place by a teacher directly
	connected with a single class cohort
Nutrition Programs	Food sales have been suspended at this time.
	Lunch Box, Pizza Days, and the school store will not be running.
	Students are encouraged to bring lunches with as little litter as
	Students are encouraged to bring lunches with as little litter as possible to reduce garbage.
Ill or Injured Students	Students cannot be sent to school showing symptoms mentioned in
in or injured students	the medical screening.
	Ill or injured students will wait in a separate supervised location
	outside the classroom.
	The school office will contact parents immediately to come to the
	school for pick up.
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	Parents should have a plan in place if a student needs to be picked
	up due to showing medical symptoms during the school day.
	The school will follow current requirements to report relevant
	symptoms to Public Health.
	Public Health provides direction to the school on follow up.
Mask Rules	All students must wear a non-medical mask on school busses and in
	the school.
	Students can remove masks when outside in their designated class
	areas.
	Teachers will try to have outdoor instructional time each day to
	allow for mask-free time.

	All adults, including staff and visitors must wear masks while on
	school property, including outside.
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	Contact the principal if you have any concerns about your student
