NOMINATION CRITERIA

- Develops trust and a mutually respectful relationship with students and athletes
- Leads by example - talented, spirited and innovative
- Emphasizes the need for fairness in sports and life
- Provides support and encouragement to enhance life skills and abilities
- Minimum of five years of coaching experience and have coached any level of high school sports in the 2015/2016 school year (may or may not be a teacher) with HWDSB or HCDSB

REQUIREMENTS

- Coaches cannot nominate themselves
- The Selection Committee will select six finalists for the Wismer Award for High School Coaching Excellence. Finalists will be informed by Tuesday, April 21, 2016.
- The six finalists will be invited to a media conference at the Canadian Football Hall of Fame on Tuesday, May 3, 2016, and introduced.
- Winners will be announced (one from the HWDSB and one from HCDSB) at the Wismer Foundation Golf Tournament and Award Presentation Dinner on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, at the Carlisle Golf and Country Club.
