Honouring those lost, Survivors and the impacts of Residential Schools.

On May 28, 2021, unmarked graves were confirmed on the site of a former residential school in Kamloops, BC. Other sites followed. The HWDSB Indigenous student leadership group, Cultivating Community: Reclaiming Our Spaces in Education (CC:ROSE), invites schools to honour those who were taken and never returned home. The Every Child Matters campaign will raise awareness about Survivor experiences and the realities of Canadian Residential Schools, which continue to impact Indigenous families and communities every day. Your Student Council invites you to participate by ordering a button designed by a CC:ROSE student, for a suggested minimum donation of \$1. Please place your orders through School Cash Online. Orders will be due by Wednesday, May 4. Proceeds will be donated to Indigenous groups and organizations that support the work of reconciliation specific to Canada's Indian Residential Schools, Survivors and Survivor's families that have been impacted.

April 28th is the National Day of Mourning, honouring those who have lost their lives, been injured or become ill in the workplace. In 2019, Canada recorded 925 workplace fatalities, including 29 young workers aged 15-24 and 271,806 claims for lost time due to a work-related injury or disease. We thank the front-line workers who continue to sustained our entire community during the pandemic, including those at HWDSB who arrive at work each day to support our students and colleagues.
