## Item 2: School Report

## **Principal's Report**

- Denise Minardi is stepping in temporarily until Mrs. Keery Bishop returns
- Current student population is 334 students (65 kindergarten, 99 primary, 98 junior and 72 intermediate)
- Staffing is ongoing Balaclava will welcome Amber Hone to a DECE position next year and Mrs. Buckle-Marshall has returned to kindergarten full time. Ms. Tudor will teach the second kindergarten class. We will have a new junior French teacher and music teacher in September. We thank Ms. Spada, Mrs. Abou Sharaf, Mme Wagner and Ms. Sheeler for being part of the Balaclava school community this year.
- The timetable creation and student placement has started. Classroom assignments will be sent out automatically through School Messenger the week before classes begin
- Kindergarten orientation was well attended with 16 families joining us for the event Kindergarten registration is ongoing so please let any neighbours know to register their child online for next September. 22 students are registered to attend kindergarten in September 2023
- Open House was also well attended and the book fair was a great success.
- Emergency drills are ongoing 2 lockdowns, 1 shelter in place, 1 hold and secure and 1 bomb threat and as well as 6 fire drills have been completed
- EQAO was completed for Grade 3 and Grade 6 students the last 2 weeks of May
- Grade 8 visit to Waterdown District High School took place on May 30
