Safe Schools Drills and Procedures

All schools are required to participate yearly in a number of safety drills including 6 fire drills, 2 lockdown drills, 1 hold and secure drill, 1 shelter in place drill, and 1 bomb threat drill. To prepare students and classes for these drills, notification is provided in the days leading up to them through our morning announcements and our educators practice or explain routines for each to our students. For lockdown, hold and secure, shelter in place and bomb threat drills, notification in advance will occur for families on the school website.

Daily Attendance Reminders

If your child is going to be absent, needs to be picked up early or will be coming into school late, please make sure to record that information in Safe Arrival. There are multiple ways families can access Safe Arrival, for details, please see:

<u>https://www.hwdsb.on.ca/secondary/supports/safearrival/</u> Planned absences can be put in as far in advance as you are able. Same day absences, however, need to be put in the system by 10 a.m. for the system to pick them up.

Please note, while office and school staff do our best to call down children for early pick up, at times this can take some time for the student to actually arrive at the front door. Please also note that early pick ups result in the disruption of learning to your child and to the other students in the class, particularly the 3:00 to 3:30 pick-ups. Please consider these factors when determining when/if to pick your child up early.

Student Bussing and Dismissal Procedures

Students at Balaclava are assigned a specific bus route and bus stop for morning and afternoon. Students are not permitted to ride on alternate buses. If your child normally rides a bus and is going to be picked up by someone instead, please ensure the teacher and office have this information well in advance of dismissal. Thank you for your assistance with this important safety procedure.
