Principal Report

Welcome to 2024! The return to school in January marks the start of a busy few months in a school. Students and educators are able to pick up where they left off in December with some renewed energy and maybe some new year resolutions. Teachers will be gathering assessment data throughout the month to use on Term 1 report cards, which come home in mid-February. If you didn't have a chance to have an interview with your child's educator(s) in November, this is an ideal time to connect with them to see how your child is doing.

Boundary Review Process

The HWDSB Board of Trustees have recently expanded an on-going boundary review to now include Balaclava School. Previously, the review was attempting to find ways to support Mary Hopkins School with their overwhelming population growth using Flamborough Centre School. Now, the review will consider Balaclava, AA Greenleaf and Guy Brown Schools in their strategy to alleviate the population strains. This month, a Public Meeting will be held on **Monday**, **January 22 at 6 p.m.** for interested families from all of those schools to hear the proposed plans and how it will impact each of the participating schools. Cold Weather Reminders

Students need to come to school prepared to be outside at recess and during some class time every day. In the winter, there may be a small number of days that we need to stay inside because the temperature falls below -15 or the windchill is below -20 but most days will see us outside at least some of the time. Students do not have the option to stay in at breaks – fresh air, exercise and a break from their classrooms is the best option to support student learning all day long. Please ensure your child is bringing clothing they will need to be safe and warm outside at school.

Use of Personal Devices at School

Currently, students are able to bring a personal device to school if approved by their parent or guardian. Keep in mind that personal devices are the sole responsibility of the student. The school and other individuals within the school are not responsible for any damage, misuse or loss. Students are only permitted to use their device during instructional time at the discretion of the teacher for educational purposes. Students cannot take photos or videos during school, including before and after school or on school transportation. Students and parents/guardians are advised to use the office for communication instead of relying on texting/phoning from student devices during class time. At this time, students are able to use their devices during non instructional time (lunch) for appropriate purposes, but are strongly encouraged to use that time instead to eat, talk with friends and take a break from their screens.

It is important to note that, while permitted, families should be cautious when determining whether your child needs the responsibility of carrying a personal device at school. If having a device at school may tempt your child to be distracted or waste time in class, or to use it for purposes inappropriate for school, it may be best to have your child leave their device at home.
