

Parent Access to School	Access to the school and school property will be very limited for parents, volunteers and visitors.
	We will be making all efforts to communicate in a virtual format throughout the school year (phone calls, email, the HUB, virtual meetings). We will be keeping families informed of developments through School Messenger and make regular posts on our school website.

## **School Parking Lot**

afternoon. If parents/caregivers are driving children to school,
parking on adjacent side streets (Pavilion Drive, Winners Way, Blue
Ribbon Way, Pumpkin Pass)

All adults picking up students must wear a mask. Students will be dismissed from their designated classroom area Designated locations for pick up: Sidewalk by main entrance at front of school for kindergarten students • Edge of field for students dismissed from blacktop **Movement Around the School** Students will remain with their class cohort throughout the day and will stay in their designated classroom. Subject specific teachers will travel to classes to provide instruction. When moving about the school, students/classes will walk on the right side, maintaining physical distancing. Parents will not be permitted into the building unless approval has been obtained by the office beforehand. **Student Belongings** Use of lockers will be paused for the time being. We will reevaluate. No shared use of lockers/hooks/cubbies. Students will keep work materials at their desks. Our change rooms will be closed so students will need to make sure they are wearing comfortable clothing for gym. Students should bring an extra mask to school in case a change needs to be made.

Students will be provided with a lanyard by the school where they

can clip their mask during nutrition break

Class Set Up	A sink or hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms.
	Each student is assigned a work-space area that ensures distancing from others.
	All desks are forward facing.
	All required work materials are located at student's workspace (not to be shared with other students).
	Students may share learning materials including books and iPads and equipment with hand washing and proper sanitizing. These materials will be cleaned on a regular basis.
FDK	We have seven kindergarten classes at Bellmoore
	All kindergarten students will wear a mask and will learn proper hand washing, physical distancing and sneezing etiquette. Our kindergarten team will take a compassionate and caring approach as children learn these enhanced safety measures.
	In the interest of safety, we ask that parents call ahead to make appointments with our team. Our goal is to enter and exit the school in an efficient and safe manner. Conversations about children will need to be scheduled or communicated through a digital format. Thanks for your understanding.
	Students will be dismissed from the kindergarten pen area. Please ensure that wait at the designated area for your child (sidewalk by main entrance)
PE, Music, Learning Commons	Physical Education (PE) Where possible, PE will take place outdoors. Students should come to school dressed to be active.
	Classes may be held in the gym with cleaning of high touchpoints between classes.
	Change rooms will be closed
	Music: Singing may take place with students wearing masks
	Learning Commons: Students may check out books from the learning commons
Nutrition Breaks	Students eat in their classrooms at their work space area.

	No sharing of food or beverages.
	Each class has a designated outdoor play area (2 m from other classes).
	Outdoor play spaces will be marked
	Masks will need to be worn when exiting the school.

Washroom Use	Students will use washrooms closest to their classrooms.
	Occupancy limits will be posted outside washrooms.
	Markings outside washrooms for physical distancing of students awaiting entry.
	Students maintain physical distancing while in washrooms.
	Urinals and stalls: every other one marked off.
	Students may use hand dryers or paper towels.
Hydration Stations	It is recommended that students bring a reusable water bottle to school filled with water at the start of the day.
	Water fountains have been closed. Three hydration stations are available for students to refill water bottles
	Markings will be visible adjacent to the hydration station to ensure physical distancing in line up.
	Hydration stations can be found across from the gym, grade 1 hallway and grade 6 hallway
Clubs and Extra curriculars	Clubs and extra-curricular may take place for mixed cohorts (masking and distancing required)
	No outside program providers will come in to schools.
Ill or Injured Students	Ill or injured students will wait in a separate supervised location.

	The school office will contact parents immediately to come to the school for pick up.
Mask Rules	All students must wear a non-medical mask or face covering on school buses and at school. Contact our school office if you have any concerns about your student wearing a mask/face covering (905-692-5435).
