RE: Class Reorganization

This school year has presented unique challenges to Ontario schools, as well as new options for students to learn in-person or remotely.

Each fall, HWDSB reviews elementary student enrolment in schools, and reorganizes staffing if actual enrolment differs from spring projections. It is normal for student enrolment to fluctuate a little.

This year, the fall reorganization is more widespread due to the in-person/remote option for students, as well as the ongoing need to meet provincial class size requirements.

Specifically, at our school, the reorganization will mean:

We will be opening a new Grade 3/4 class (Mrs. Gibbons) and closing both our Grade 4/5 (Ms Pliura) and Grade 7/8 (Mrs. Lohchab) classes. We are also saying good bye to the following Occasional Teachers: Mr. Morrallee, Ms. Biggs, Mrs. Biggley, Mrs. Lohchab, Mrs. Harder aand Mrs. Sawchuck.

All Grade 4 students form the 4/5 class are moving into the new Grade 3/4 class with Mrs. Gibbons. The Grade 5 students from the 4/5 class, will be moving in small numbers to the existing Grade 5 classes.

The Grade 7/8 students, will also move in small groups into the existing Grade 7 and 8 classes.

Careful consideration has been put into all student movement in order to maintain a sense of student community in all classrooms. Students impacted, will have received additional communication regarding class changes.
