Virtual PA Day Workshops for HWDSB students with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

Information for students and families

The Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board is partnering with Bethesda Children's Services to offer PA Day workshops for students with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) through the After School Skills Development Program (ASSDP). Please see the attached flyers for service options.

Please note the following:

- Families/students who wish to register for a workshop will need to register directly with Bethesda (see flyer).
- Only HWDSB students may register for the listed virtual PA Day workshops.
- Students may request up to 1-hour of individual follow up after each workshop.
- Bethesda is an approved Ontario Autism Program (OAP) provider. As a provider they will ask if you/the student are registered with the OAP. Students <u>do not</u> need to be registered with the OAP to access these services, however students who are registered with the OAP may be offered additional services through Bethesda's OAP services.
- Some information will be collected by Bethesda and shared with the ASSDP (e.g.: number of registrants, satisfaction survey results, service data elements) <u>for service</u> <u>evaluation and ministry reporting</u> purposes only. No identifying student information will be shared from Bethesda to HWDSB without student/ guardian consent.
- Workshops will run on Blue Jeans Health. This is a secure platform; however, it is not supported on HWDSB devices. Instructions on how to participate will be shared after registration and consent to participation is received.
- Workshops will not be recorded.
- An ASSDP employee may at times be present to monitor quality of service
