
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

## What to expect in Grade 9

• The year has two semesters:

4 classes each semester = 8 classes in total

- Semester 1: Sept to Jan
- Semester 2: Feb to June
- Each school day is made up of 4 classes of 75 min each
- 1 hour for lunch and two 10 min breaks between morning and afternoon classes


In grade 9, all students will take a common Grade 9

### **Specialized Services: Locally Developed Courses**

#### What is a Locally Developed Course?

 These courses review and reinforce the elementary level curriculum expectations to provide the necessary skills for further study at the secondary level. These courses lead to workplace pathway courses in grade 11 and 12

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## Specialized Services: Locally Developed Courses

- Recommendations for specialized programming will be made using a team approach involving elementary and secondary school staff, the student, and their family.
- Specialized programming in locally developed courses can include courses in ENGLISH, MATH and SCIENCE
- Note: This option will not be available on XELLO, but will be a discussion between the elementary school, student, parent and entered into Xello by the secondary team

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# OSSD Graduation Requirements

- 30 Credits (19 compulsory & 11 elective)
- Literacy Requirement (OSSLT in Grade 10)
- 40 hours of Community Service Involvement


#### **40 Hours Community Service**
