Parents/Guardians are welcome to register in person on **Monday, February 5** - **9:00 am to 2:30 pm.** If you are not available to come on this day, ongoing registration is available Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 2:30 pm. If you are not available to come during these times, please call the office and inquire about getting a registration package. Please share this information with your friends and neighbours who have children that will turn 4 or 5 years old before the end of December of this year. Early registration helps us accurately capture enrollment and staff our program for September.

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### New school website coming soon

Billy Green will unveil its new school website during the month of February. This represents the first significant update to the look of our school website since 2013.

School websites in HWDSB are being enhanced to improve the standards associated with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA).

Websites will be easier to navigate from mobile devices, display standardized icons for accessibility, offer larger font size and place a greater emphasis on the search function, to name some enhancements.

## **SafeArrival**

At Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB), one of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely at school every day.





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To enhance our absence-checking procedure, we have introduced the student absence reporting system **SafeArrival**. This will save time to verify a student attendance, make it easy for you to report your child's absence and easy for staff to respond to unexplained student absences.

With **SafeArrival**, families report a child's absence in one of three ways:

Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store (or from links at https://go.schoolmessenger.com). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
Use the SafeArrival website, https://go.schoolmessenger.com. The first time you use the website,

select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

3. Call the toll-free number 844-506-4350 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, seven days a week. You can report a future absence any time.

In addition, we will use the **SchoolMessenger Communicate** automated notification system to contact parents whose child is absent when the absence was not reported in advance. The automated notification system will attempt to contact parents multiple times until parents submit a reason for their child's absence. If this system cannot reach the designated contacts, office staff will follow up.

If you report your child's absence in advance using the **SafeArrival** toll-free number, website or mobile app, you will NOT receive these notifications.

Please report absences in advance using **SafeArrival** instead of sending notes or calling/emailing the school. Staff will be using the **SafeArrival** notifications to let you know if your student is absent (when you haven't reported the absence in advance).

If you have children attending other schools, please continue to report absences using the existing procedures for those schools. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we implement this new system.
