# Trips

Camp trip for 6-8 is not happening this year

A survey went out regarding possible trip for grade 7 and 8 with very low response Ottawa won't happen as we need 40 students to commit before paperwork begins Now looking at possible day trip options

## 6. Principal's Report

Report card data showed increase in literacy and numeracy level 3 and 4 achievements

EQAO survey showed an increase in student confidence in math when responding to "I am good at math" 44% in 23/24 and 51.4% in 24/25

Our student MDI showed a decrease in the number of students feeling alone but also showed a consistent decrease in students feeling like they belong to the school

Spring student voice survey showed students felt joy when validated and heard

There's a trend where some students expressed not feeling as though they are validated

Comments such as: "if adults took more action when a student comes to them for help"
"opportunity to share views"

"students that would understand people and how they would feel about

situations"

School focus for September has been creating classroom conditions

all teachers have worked in their classrooms to talk about and create classroom agreements that were grounded in compassion, trust, dignity and joy

Staff have worked in division teams to discuss the framework of belonging: how to create belonging at the school and what does that mean in terms of school and classroom community?

Next focus will be on strategizing for specific action with resources and instruction

Focus on knowing our students and using not just curriculum but understanding identity and joy Ministry mandated Reorganization for this school year is in process

Not a school decision

Schools are required to submit the number of students who are in attendance

Billy Green had a decrease in the projected numbers from the spring vs. the September numbers

Grade 4 class changing to a grade 4/5 class

Grade 5/6 changing to a grade class

FDK will have 2 classes with 2 educators, and one class with no more than 15 students and one teacher Notice went out to families on September 19

Ms. Beatrice called all FDK students who were moving to a new class

When reorganizing classes, it is a collaborative process for placing students: looking at strengths, needs and peer groupings

PRO Grant deadline is November 21
