Principal's Message

Dear Billy Green Families,

As we begin a new month, we continue our school-wide focus on belonging, aligned with HWDSB's commitment to ensuring every student feels included, valued, and supported.

EQAO: We are also proud to share our EQAO results from last spring. Our students demonstrated hard work and perseverance, with strong achievements across both divisions. Our grade 3 math results continue to show a trending growth from 56% of students meeting level 3 in 2022-2023 to 63% of grade 3 students meeting provincial standards last year. Our grade 6 results show significant growth in all areas. 93% of students meeting provincial standard in Reading and 88% meeting provincial standard in Writing. Math results continue to trend in growth where 23% of grade 6 students met provincial standard in 2022-2023 and 58% meeting provincial standard last year. The data shows a need to continue to focus on strategies to support mathematics. Further information of our school annual plan will be shared in the upcoming month.

Student Voice: A heartfelt thank-you to our Student Voice Committee for leading a successful December Candy Gram fundraiser, and to our amazing staff for coordinating the dance, theme days, and many other community-building activities. We also appreciate our BLING Committee for helping decorate and add sparkle to our school environment.

Warm Wishes: This month, many families will be observing important days of significance, including Chinese New Year, the start of Ramadan fasting, and Ash Wednesday. We extend warm wishes to all who are celebrating. As always, if your child requires any accommodations, please contact the office—we are here to support you.

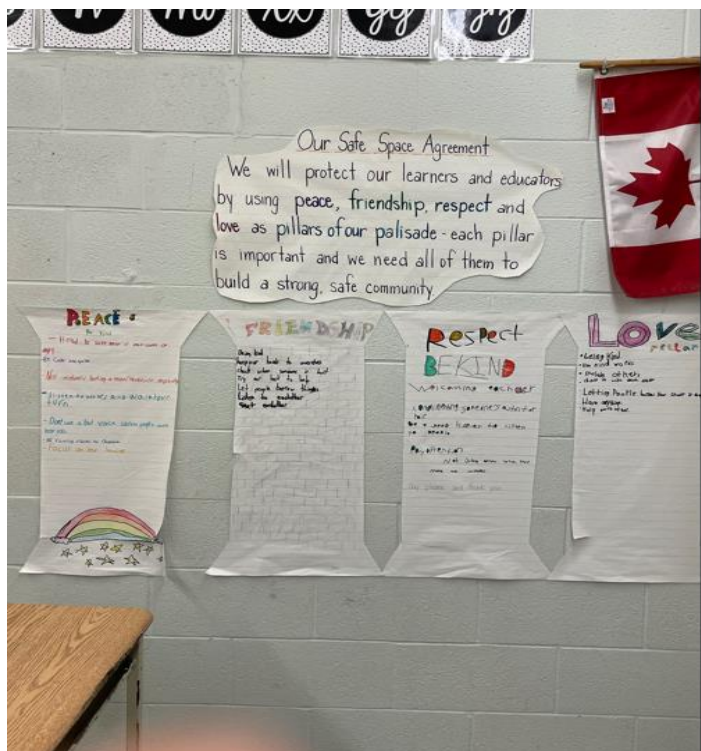

Learning in Action: Grade 6–8 Cave Springs Experience May 13th-15th, 2026

We are excited to announce a learning experience for students in Grades 6, 7, and 8 to Cave Springs Camp in Beamsville, Ontario.

This experience is designed to support learning connected to the application of classroom skills, including science, geography, visual arts, leadership, and collaboration.

The experience intentionally aligns with expectations from the Ontario Curriculum, providing students with meaningful, hands-on learning opportunities.

To support and maximize student participation, two trip options are available:

- **Option 1:** A one-day, extended day trip on Wednesday, May 13
- **Option 2:** A 3-day, 2-night trip from May 13–15

Because the learning opportunities for this experience are so rich and require significant planning and staffing, we are aiming for **at least 90% student participation** across Grades 6–8. High participation ensures that all students benefit from this shared learning experience.

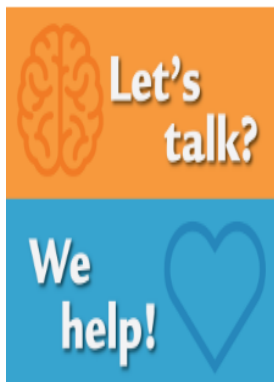

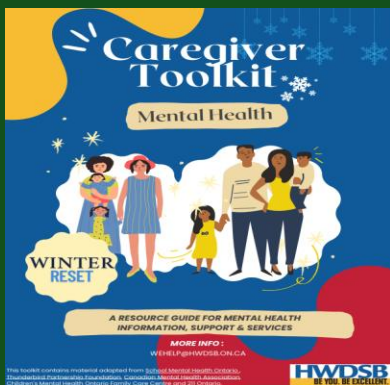
Supporting Mental Health & Well-being
