- 1. CE's On-Line Learning Summer program is available to all HWDSB Secondary School students, Adults, Visa Students and Secondary School Students from other boards and private schools.
- 2. ALL HWDSB STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE THEIR COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM TO THEIR GUIDANCE COUNSELLOR TO REGISTER (an appointment may be required).
- 3. All On-Line Learning students who are currently registered in a day school (outside of HWDSB) must have permission from their day school to register and must provide a signed and sealed copy of this form at time of registration.
- 4. Registration requires your OEN number and valid e-mail address. Please make sure this information is provided on the Registration form.
- 5. Participants will be granted access to an online orientation resource prior to their course start date. Participants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the On-Line Learning platform ("the HUB"/D2L) through this resource. Details will be provided at registration and/or by e-mail prior to the scheduled session start date.
- 6. Courses can be cancelled due to insufficient enrolment. Students will be notified by CE if their course is cancelled.
- 7. A fee of \$1662.50 (2018/2019 fee) is required for all International Students. International students must contact the Assessment Centre. Please call 905-521-2554 to arrange for payment of course fees prior to registering.
- 8. Students may take only one course per session through the On-Line Learning program with the exception of Careers and Civics.
- 9. Students must show proof of eligibility and Ontario address at the time of registration. Students who do not currently attend a Secondary School with HWDSB will be required to complete an attestation form to verify identification and eligibility at the time of registration. **Driver's License, Health Card and Ontario ID card are not accepted to prove eligibility.**
