Who can Participate?

Participants must be over 21 with at least 24 credits** and currently employed fulltime.

Participants with stable employment, preferably with the same employer for more than 6 months are preferred or students working with employment training programs will be considered.

** If you have a credit count lower than 21 you may be eligible for a credit assessment, call (905) 521-2554 to book appointment, or visit 110 King Street West, Plaza Suite 606.

What is Work for Credit?

The *Work for Credit* program is a cooperative education experience allowing participant to earn secondary credits through a structured job experience.

AT WORK: Students can earn up to 2 credits in a 6 week session, based on the number of hours worked.

COURSE WORK: There are weekly online assignments to complete and at least 3 face-to-face visits with the instructor.

EMPLOYER'S ASSESSMENT: Employer's consent and a supervisor's assessment of performance is also a requirement.
