Who can Register?

Participants must be over 21 with at least 24 credits^{**} and currently employed full time or participating in structured training to improve employment opportunities.

** If you have a credit count lower than 24 you may be eligible for maturity credits.

Registration is done online followed by a face to face orientation meeting.

What is Work for Credit?

The *Work for Credit* program is a cooperative education experience allowing participant to earn secondary credits through a job or training experience.

AT WORK: Students can earn up to 2 credits in a 6 week session, based on the number of hours worked and assignments completed.

COURSE WORK: There are weekly online assignments to complete and at least 3 face-to-face visits with the instructor.

EMPLOYER'S ASSESSMENT: Employer's consent and a supervisor's assessment of performance is also a requirement.
