User Account Information

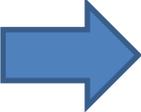
Current HWDSB students will use the same login credentials as those currently used to access HWDSB school computers.

You ***must*** use your HWDSB email account for all subsequent communication between yourself, your teacher and/or CE staff. This is for your security so that we can ensure any electronic communication is coming from you.

First Time Users (new to HWDSB)

Your user name and new password will be used to access your account at students.hwdsb.on.ca – see screen shot below.

STEP ONE: Navigate to students.hwdsb.on.ca and enter the User ID and the password **provided to you via your personal email.**

We strongly suggest changing the password from the default and registering for password Self-Service right away.

STEP TWO: From the main students.hwdsb.on.ca page click on "The HUB" where you can access your course.

DO NOT USE GOOGLE to search for HWDSB's On-Line Learning site.
