APPLICATION and PLACEMENT PROCESS:

STEP 1: BETWEEN APRIL 3 and MAY 1 - COMPLETE YOUR ON-LINE APPLICATION FORM

STEP 2: MAY 4 – ATTEND MANDATORY onsite ORIENTATION Meeting at Hill Park Learning Centre - 6pm to 9pm

IMPORTANT: Summer Co-op students must also attend Thursday May 11, 18, 25, June 1 (June 8 Optional) Preplacement classes

- All Summer Co-op students must complete the on-line placement as it is part of your co-op hours.
- Email summercoop@hwdsb.on.ca if you have questions.

STEP 3: Prepare a Cover Letter and Resume – between MAY 4 and 10 (see Lesson 2 in the pre-placement course)

• The preplacement class on Thursday May 11 at Hill Park you must have a cover letter and resume prepared for a mock interview.

STEP 4: Placement Search – between MAY 4 and JUNE 9

- The summer co-op job board can be found at HWDSB Summer Co-op Placement Possibilities
- Apply to potential employers/volunteer opportunities either from the job board or you can source you own contacts.
- Consider that you may have to interview with multiple employers give yourself lots of time!
- Ideally you should have a placement secured by June 9th.

STEP 5: Complete Preplacement Course – by JUNE 9

• The completion date for the preplacement course is June 9, your co-op teacher will assist you with options if it is not complete.

STEP 6: Complete the Placement Confirmation Form to confirm your Summer Co-op Placement – by JUNE 9

• Once you secure a placement complete the online form with your placement details, at the link below:

STEP 7: FIRST DAY at CO-OP on JULY 4 (IF Co-op Ready) OR CHECKIN Day at Hill Park (IF NOT Co-op Ready)

• All co-op teachers will be at Hill Park from 9:00am to 2:00pm to address the needs of students who are not CO-OP READY, i.e. they do not have the required WEA forms, OR have not completed the preplacement course, OR do not have a secured placement, OR do not have access to MTEL (co-op software management tool).

STEP 8: Attend Secured Placement between JULY 4 to 28

- The expectation is that you attend your placement daily for 8 hours per day.
- Assignments during the Co-op session will include daily log sheets (using MTEL the co-op management software), a mid-term and a final
 assignment.
- WORKPLACE VISITS: Your Co-op teacher will conduct up to 3 workplace visits during the Co-op session.
- During the session you will required to attend all scheduled reflection days at the Hill Park Learning Centre.

Central Placement Students ONLY – (must attend extra weeks JULY 31 to AUG 4)

Students at Hospital, Art Gallery or SPCA placements will be attending their placement for an additional week.

STEP 9: JULY 28 Session Complete – 2 Credits Earned
