Department/Program Description

The ALC (Alternate Level of Care) units are located on 2 Marian (21 beds) and 6 JIT (31 beds). Patients on these units are typically waiting for a long-term care, retirement home or assisted living placement in the community.

The patient population served is senior with many patients having a cognitive deficit. The units are locked to ensure the patients do not wander off the unit unsafely.

Services are provided by an interdisciplinary team and provides a holistic approach across the continuum of health.
