

SAFETY REMINDERS:

No Nuts or Nut Products Please: We still have some students bringing in items that have nuts or nut products and/or oils. We have several children who have life threatening allergies. Please check all foods and food packages to be sure they do not contain any nut products, or nut oils. Thank you.

Absences/Lates: Attendance and punctuality is critical for your child's learning, achievement and well-being. If your child is going to be absent or late, please contact the school at 905-522-9690, and provide the following information:

- Child's name
- Reason for absence/late (and timelines)
- Child's grade
- Child's teacher

Any student arriving late must check into the office upon their arrival. Our start time is 8:45 a.m., and many of our classes start with Literacy, while the

students are most alert. That being said, all of the classes are important to your child's education, and if your child is late regularly, he/she will be missing a significant portion of these important lessons.

Checking in at the Office: When visiting Central School, please ring the buzzer, and upon entry, go directly to the office

to check in. If you are dropping off something for your child, please leave it at the office, and we will deliver it to your child. Thank you.

Visitors/Volunteers: If you are visiting or volunteering at Central, please sign-in on the appropriate sign-in list in the office. This is very important, as if we have an emergency in the building, we need to know that everyone in the building is accounted for, and safe. Thank you very much for this.

Clothing Swap – by Central School Council

The very successful Clothing Swap returns on Tuesday November 15, 2016 from 2:30-3:30pm. Please drop off your clean used clothing during the week. Items welcome: winter coats, snow suits, snow pants, hats, scarves, mittens, warm clothing for children and adults, lightly used boots and toys. These items will be offered at the swap for free. You do not have to donate to take clothing. You do not have to pay for items. There is no limit to the amount of clothes you may take from the swap. This is a great way for our community to share the things we and our children have grown out of and it has been very successful in the past. 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Strollers: Unfortunately, we **cannot allow** strollers into our school, as it **does not meet with Fire Regulations**. We are sorry for this inconvenience. As an alternative, you may wish to lock your stroller to the fence outside (you would have to provide the lock yourself). Also, we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. I apologize for the inconvenience, and thank you for following this rule.

Cold Weather

As the cold weather approaches, please be sure your child(ren) is/are dressed appropriately for the weather. Students will be waiting outside before and after school, and they will be going out for recess each day – weather permitting.

On rainy, or extremely cold weather days, students will be brought into the gym, in the morning. Please say good-bye to your child(ren) at the door as we do not have enough room in the gym to accommodate parents and children.

Also, please do not congregate in the vestibule at the entry door. Crowding in this area is a safety concern. Thank you.

Reminder of Emergency Drills

The Hamilton District School Board has a primary responsibility to ensure the safety of students and staff inside Board buildings and on Board property. The "Emergency Lockdown Procedure" is initiated, should a high risk incident occur. The chances are rare, but we must be prepared. High risk situations can be anything involving weapons, hazardous spills, severe weather warnings, student/stranger intrusion, rabid animals loose in the yard/school, circumstances at another school facility or in the immediate area that could endanger the safety of students and/or staff. In order for all students and staff to continue to become familiar with the expectations during a lockdown, our school will be practising the emergency lockdown procedures. We will be holding our first lockdown drill prior to the Winter Holidays. During these drills, the doors will be locked and no one will be allowed into the school. This is the same procedure that will be followed in a real situation.

We use the following terminology across the board for the various Emergency Procedures:

Lockdown: Potentially violent situation at the school

Safety situation in the neighbourhood external to the school Hold and Secure: Shelter in Place: Potentially environmental hazard outside the school

As previously stated, we will be holding drills for the various procedures throughout the school year. We had our first three fire drills, and so far they have all been successful - thank you to everyone for following the appropriate procedures.
